1. How is anti-social behaviour being addressed if there is only one anti-social behaviour officer?
2. Is it correct he has other duties and is only dealing with what is regarded as high level anti-social behaviour?
3. If anti-social behaviour is escalated through to the court system what legal capacity do we have to meet the needs?
4. How do officers and residents get a satisfactory response to there needs if the the anti-social behaviour structure has been greatly reduced?
5. Why was there no involvement with councillors across the Town on this re-designation and redundancies?
6. Has the council given up on its anti-social role and if so why have you not informed the residents on these considerable changes?
