1. Purpose and Reasons

- 1.1 This report provides the Children's Health, Social Care and Education O&S Committee with a briefing on the Swindon Local Digital Roadmap (LDR) and an update on key projects from the LDR
- 1.2 A key purpose of the Children's Health, Social Care and Education O&S Committee is to hold Commissioners of Health and Social Care Services to account.
- 1.3 Any Commissioner of Health and Social Care Services in Swindon is required to provide information on the planning and provision of health and social care services within the Borough and consult with the Committee on any planned substantial changes or developments to service provision.

3. Detail

Please see attached publish summary version of the Swindon Local Digital Roadmap (LDR). CCGs were required by NHS England to create and publish LDRs.

The local digital roadmap identifies high level digital capabilities required over the next 5 years and some key projects to help us achieve these aims.

One key area of focus is improving patient care as a result of better integration and interoperability between the many different IT systems in use

3.1 Key Projects from the LDR that were identified are as follows: -

- Swindon (or wider) shared care record including End of Life planning and mental health information (currently exploring Blackpear eSP)

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- Increase utilisation of existing national systems e.g. Summary Care Record (SCR), Electronic prescribing ESP, Patient online services, e-referrals
 - Need for Swindon or STP wide network / COIN as a replacement for N3 and also to act as an enabler for other digital projects.
 - Continuation and development of electronic transfer of urgent care information between GP to urgent care centres (currently using Blackpear eRA)
 - Making better use of existing systems e.g increase Docman Electronic Document Transfers (EDT) and install viewers for main clinical systems at key providers

3.2 Key Local Digital Roadmap Projects update as of December 2017

Swindon IT Steering Group has now been established, with representation from GWH, Swindon BC, CCG and GP IT

Primary care IT strategy agreed with Clinical Leadership Group

Blackpear End of Life Plans (ETTF) Project – Funding secured via ETTF, order now placed with Blackpear for electronic shared plans (eSP). Finalised electronic form/plan in conjunction with GPs, Secondary Care & local Prospect Hospice, currently awaiting Black pear to make form live in production so testing can begin. Highlight reports being sent to NHSE as part of ETTF process.

Swindon or STP Wide COIN– Fully engaged with HSCN (N3 replacement) procurement, Swindon CCG Assistant Director of IT is leading STP wide HSCN working group. Specifications have now been finalised including requirement for COIN, procurement due to go live Jan 2018. NHS England bid submitted to create primary care wide single domain\network

NHS Wi-Fi – Patient and Staff Guest Wi-Fi now installed in all Swindon GP surgeries

e-referrals (Increasing use of national systems) – Project underway to increase usage of e-referral, local Optimise referral solution now decommissioned (1st April 2017) and replaced with local CAS services on e-referrals. NHS England bid submitted for referral management document management system.

Electronic Prescribing (Increasing use of national systems) – Swindon CCG prescription ordering direct service (POD) now live providing service for 16 practices with 2 more due in the next few months. This will improve EPS utilisation as practice required to use EPS to sign all prescriptions created via the POD.

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Blackpear eRA (electronic transfer of urgent care information) – New provider for SUCCESS urgent care centres (Medvivo) has taken over as of 1st April, currently working with Medvivo and Blackpear to enable out of hours service to electronically book into weekend SUCCESS appointments.

Docman (Making better use of existing Systems) – Project underway to enable all Swindon practices to receive clinical correspondence from key providers via Docman EDT. NHS England bid submitted to upgrade practice to Docman 10 Docman 10

3.3 Future Digital Roadmap Plans

Work is currently taking place at STP level to review the 3 CCG's local digital roadmaps / future digital requirements and develop an STP wide plan for those projects that have benefits to be delivered at STP level.

It is likely that future NHS England funding will need to be signed off at STP level so local alignment and input into STP objectives will be key.
