Having left supported living it is challenging to leave care, identify what income they are entitled to/can earn and learn to budget all at the same time. This assistance would help them as they manage their income and learn to budget the cost of high living, particularly with rents and other necessities (energy and food) on the increase.</p> <p>21-25 year olds: If the payment could cause undue hardship then yes, absolutely.</p> <p>Alongside the proposed measures, financial inclusion and capability training should be offered to give them a better financial start to life.</p> |
