

## Writing an obituary

When somebody dies an obituary is often put in the paper, especially for someone who is famous or important. It tries to explain what was important about the person who died, and why they will be remembered. When you write your obituary try and include the following things.

- Name of the person who has died
- Date and Place of birth
- Date and Place of death
- Details of their childhood, such as where they lived, and who their parents were
- Details of their later life, such as whether they were married or had children, and some of the important things they did or said
- Why they will be remembered – try to pick some of the most important reasons to remember this person
