

# Indiana Jones

## and the LAST CRUSADE – Teacher's Video Sheet

**The story:** The adventurous archaeologist, Indiana Jones, teams up with his father in a battle of good versus evil, in the search for the Holy Grail.

**Topic:** Hinduism - Sacred Literature

**Year:** 8

**Lesson number:** 1

**Start clip:** (1 hour 40 minutes 40 seconds) Indiana and the group arrive at the temple where the Holy Grail is kept.

**End clip:** (1 hour 56 minutes 30 seconds) Indiana's father is healed.

**Setting For the clip:** Indiana Jones and his father have reached the temple where the Holy Grail is kept, but not before the Nazis (led by an American Business man) who are also searching for the Holy Grail. Indiana is forced to take the trail to get the Grail. To complete this he refers to several different sources of authority he has come across in his life.

**Suggested questions:** What sources of authority does Indiana use to recover the Holy Grail? What sources of authority do we use in a dilemma? What sources of authority do religious people use in a dilemma?

**Suggested answers:** His father's diary, his father's teachings, lessons at school (Latin), his faith, his reasoning.
