

Consequences Game

The aim of this funny game, to be used as a starter or plenary is to see that actions and words have consequences.

Pupils to be in small groups of 3 or 4

Give each pupil an A5 size piece of paper and write the names of their group on the back of the page.

(Explain that anything written that is inappropriate will be dealt with)

Explain that each person will write something on the paper at the top and then fold it forward a few times so that no-one can see. Then they are to pass the paper to the next person in the group. This will happen several times leading to the group writing on several bits of paper and writing and folding so as not to reveal anything. At the end they can open the piece of paper up and read a funny story.

The first thing they write is a famous man's name (fold paper forward and pass on to next person)

The second thing they write is a famous woman's name (fold paper etc)

The third thing they write is where the couple meet (fold paper etc)

The next thing they write is a question the man asks the woman. (fold etc) Remind them to write appropriate things!

Then they write what the woman says in return. (Fold etc)

Finally they write out what happened in the end.

They spend a few minutes reading them out and choose the funniest one and can share it with the class
