Your sister ate all the crisps from the cupboard – your mum accuses your little brother of eating them, and sends him to his room			
You have forgotten to do your homework. The teacher asks you why you have not handed it in.			
Someone has been bullying you. You are alone with them, and could hurt them without getting caught.
