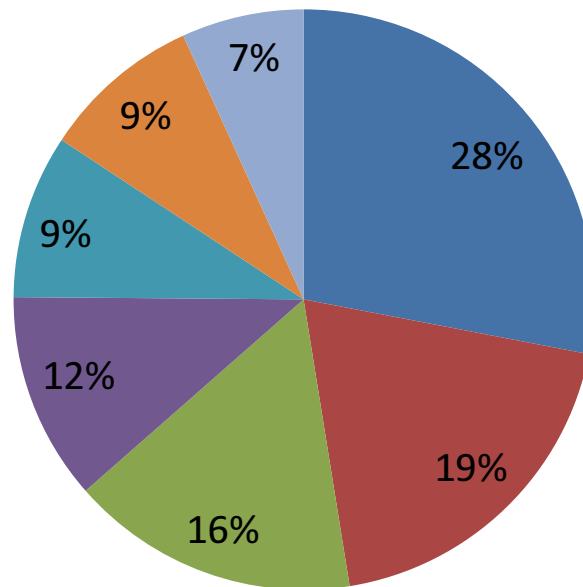


WILTSHIRE POLICE

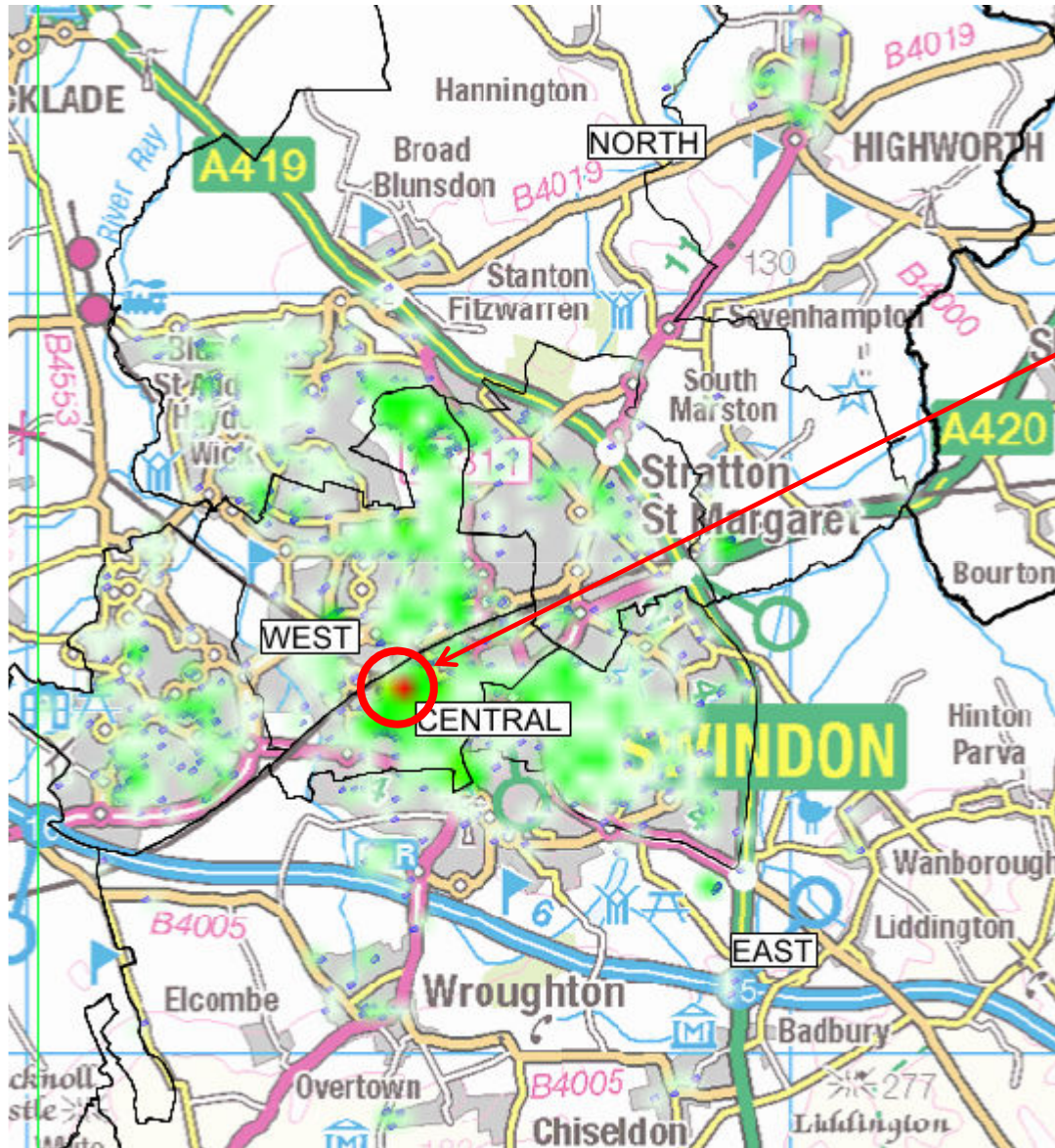

Hotspot in Central Swindon

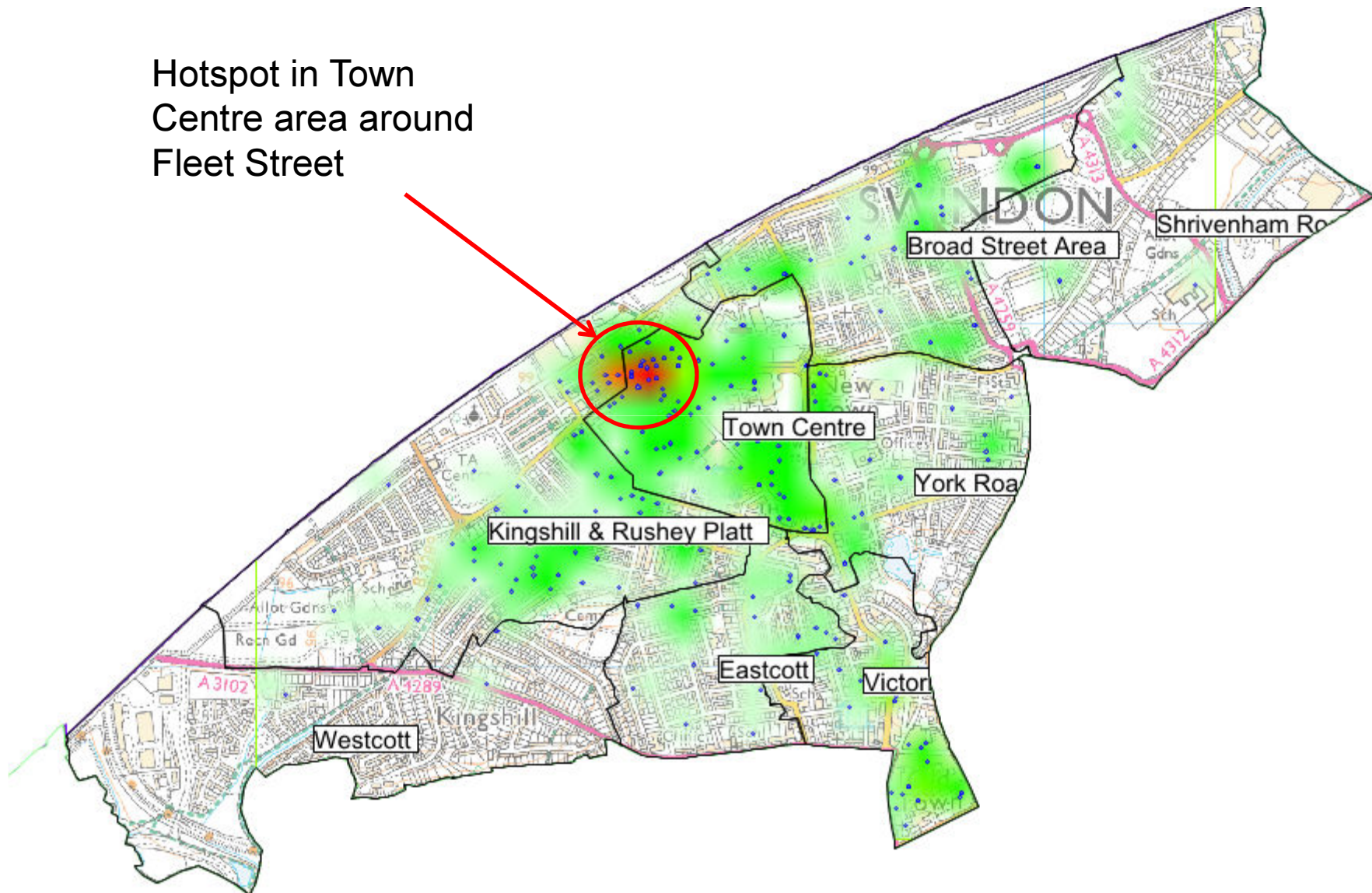

Fleet Street

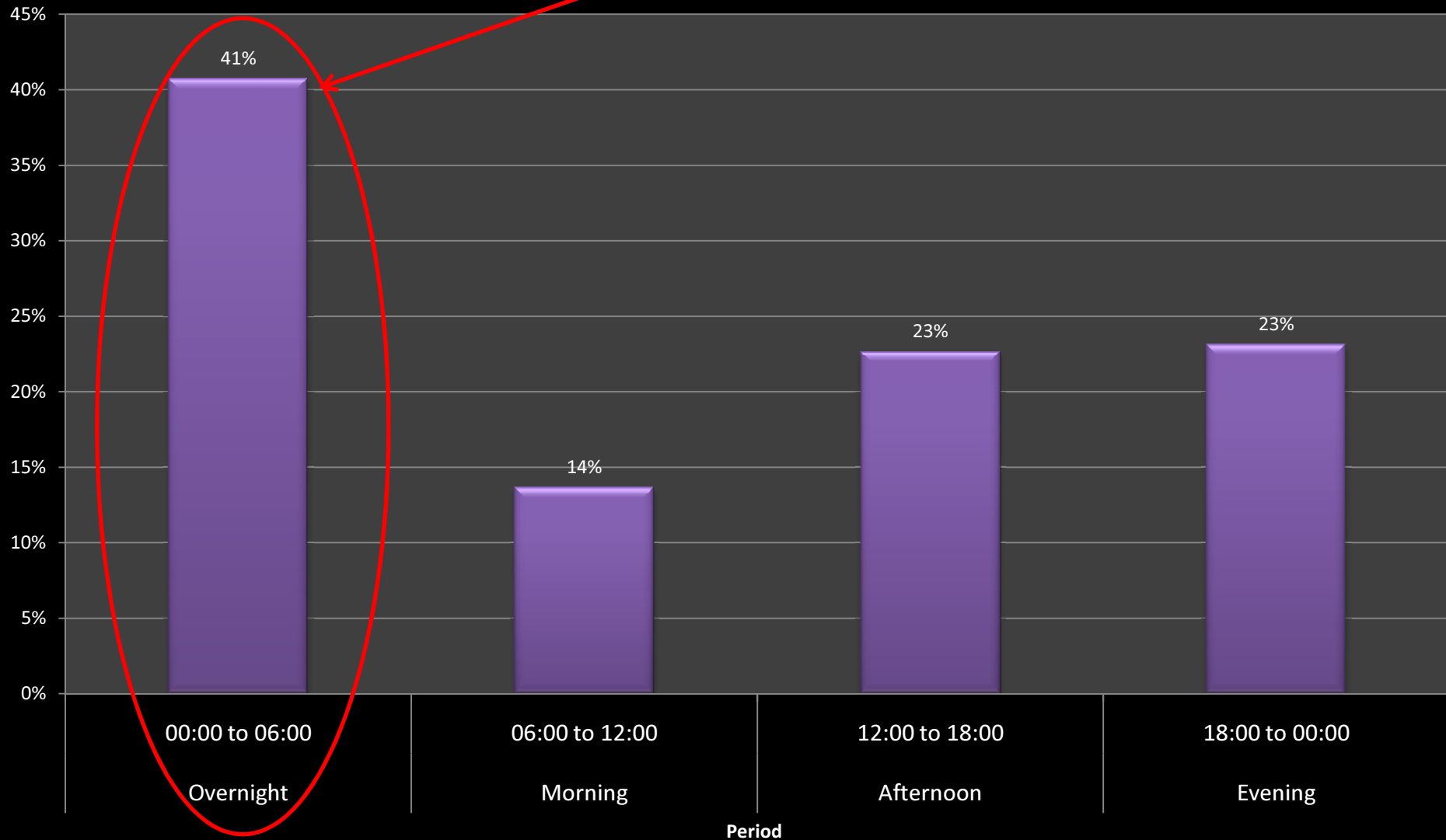

PEAK PERIOD OF DAY



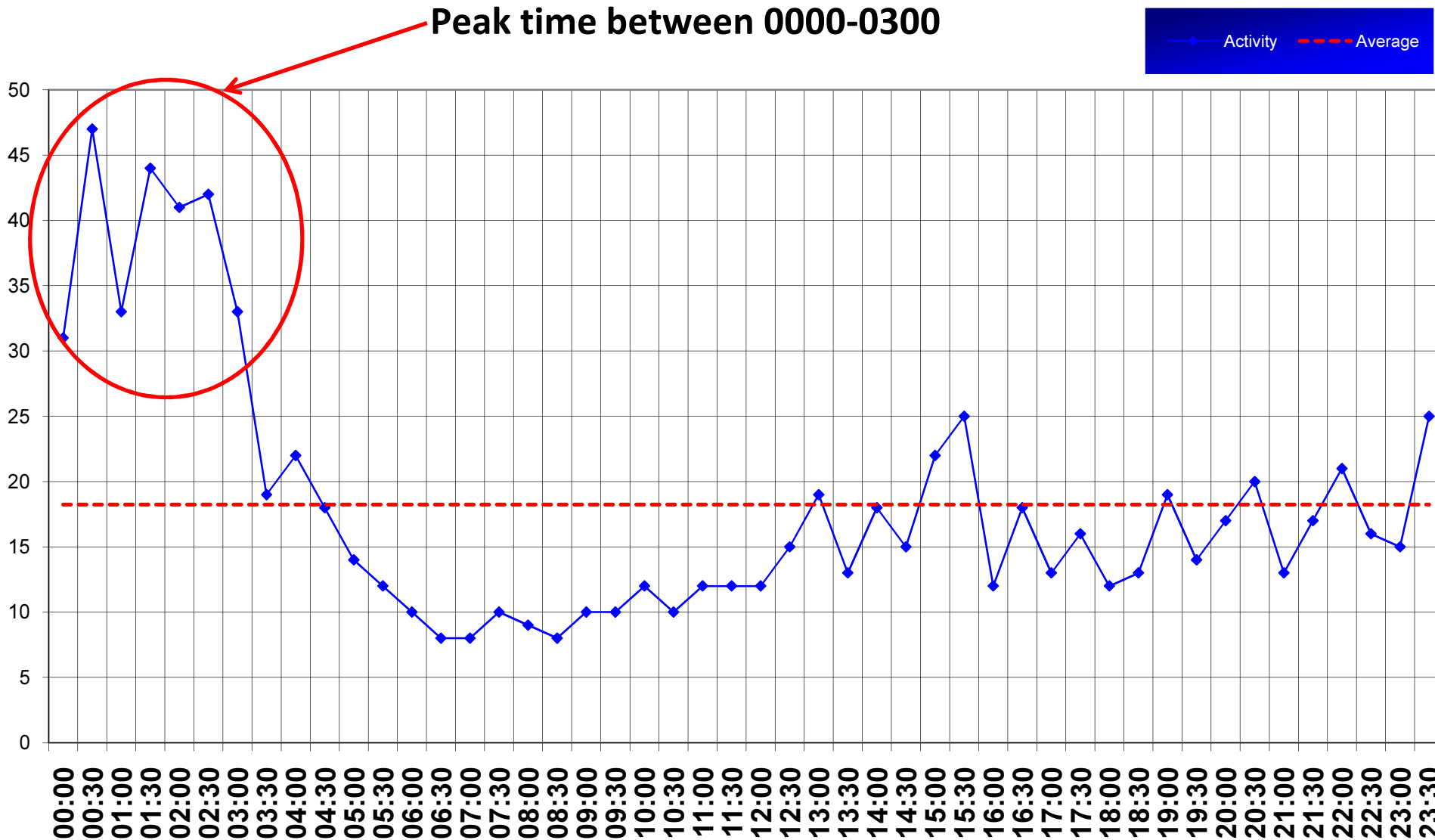

Peak time between 0000-0300

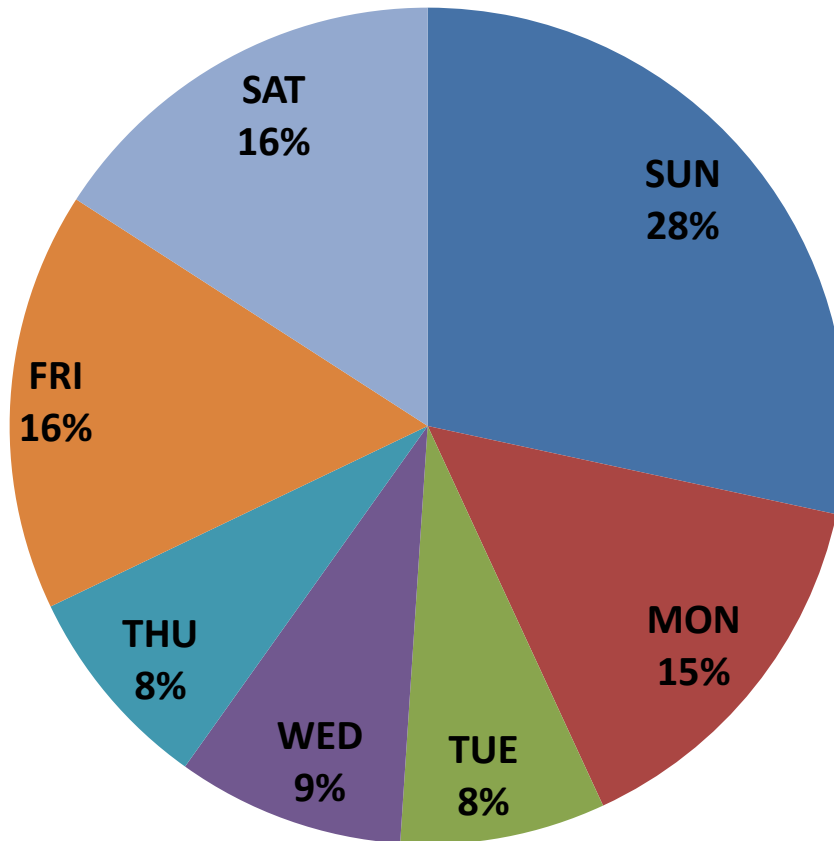
