Subject **Sale of Land at Wichelstowe for a Supermarket**

Decision(s): - Further to Minute 83 of the Cabinet, the Cabinet Member for Finance authorises the Director of Law and Democratic Services in consultation with the Board Director, Finance, Revenues, Benefits and Property and the Head of Property Assets to proceed with a conditional sale of the site identified in the plan attached as Appendix 1 to the party named in the body of the Decision Note, to build a supermarket at Wichelstowe, subject to the disposal being conditional upon planning consent for a supermarket being obtained, for the price set out in the Decision Note which has been established by an independent valuer acting on behalf of the Council, and on such other terms and conditions as are required by the Director of Law and Democratic Services, Director of Finance, Revenues, Benefits and Property, and Head of Property Assets to protect the Council's interests.

Consultation: The Shadow / Group Spokespersons - Councillor Des Moffatt (Labour) and Councillor Dave Wood (Liberal Democrat), and Wroughton and Wichelstowe Ward Councillors were consulted on the contents of the Decision Note.

Councillor Des Moffatt supported the proposal.

Councillor Brian Ford commented that he supported the proposal and that it should be possible to increase the number of parking spaces at the site. He has also advised that he would plead with the Cabinet Member that a footpath and cycleway was needed from Wroughton down Wharf Road and Mill Lane to the proposed store. He has also commented that the suggestion by officers that there is already a path to Wichelstowe from Wroughton was correct but was in completely the wrong direction and ended over a mile from the proposed Supermarket and is not near Wharf Road.

Councillor Ann Richards supported the proposal and commented that she also felt more parking could be provided. She reiterated the need for a cycle path/footpath/bridleway along Wharf Road which was something the Ward councillors, the Parish Council and Vision4Wroughton have been campaigning for, for over 20 years.

No further responses were received by the response deadline.
