I write to you regarding the concerns we have should you decide to
Once again close the access route from Cricklade Road into
Queensfield during rush hours. When the road is closed off purely at the
request of a minority of residents, then everyone else has to suffer. other
residents have problems as they cannot re-enter Queensfield from
dropping children at school or merely having to pop out & returning
before 9.30am, they have to go all the way down Cricklade Road & up
Beechcroft Rd & then through Hathaway Rd.....So much for reducing
carbon emissions!! Also what makes the minority of Queensfield
residents who have a problem with this access any better than the
residents of Hathaway Rd/Beechcroft, is it a case of 'Not in my back

In the local shop in queensfield we made a petition for a week. We got
374 signatures in total to keep the road open. From the 374 signatures 190
people who live in queensfield and close around.(x) 141 signatures were
people who use the road from penhill into queensfield(xx) 43 signatures
were passing customers.(-) see the signatures in the copies provided.
This is a small activity to show you how many people were affected by it.

The solution for the problems is speed limits or speed bumps. Then both
parties are happy.
