

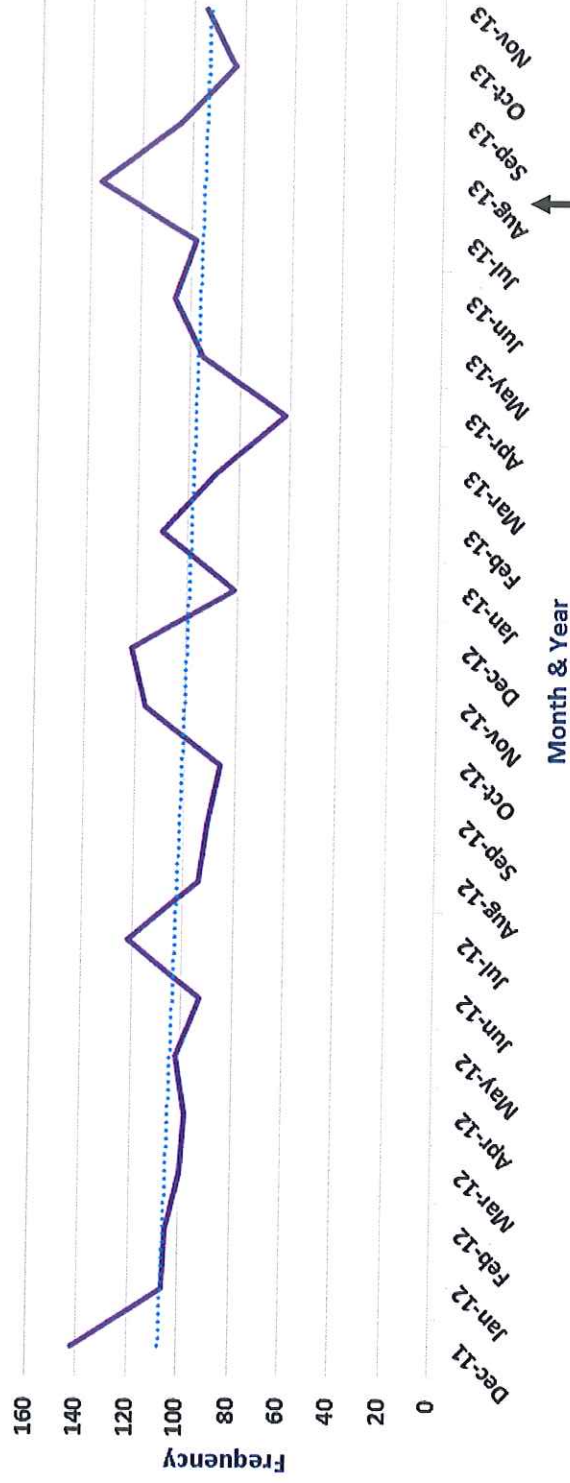

# Incidents

- During the 24 month data period there were 2439 incidents recorded on Storm which fulfilled the aforementioned criteria. This equates to an average of 101.6 (to 1dp.) per month or 23.5 (to 1dp.) per week.
- As can be seen from the below chart, the general trend is a reduction in the number of recorded incidents. However, there is a noticeable peak in incidents occurring in August 2013. This increase is not directly attributable to the opening of the Brunel Rooms, however it has been seen that in order to compete with the presence of a new venue other licensed premises have offered extensive drinks promotions to entice customers to their establishments. As a consequence members of the public may be increasingly intoxicated and thus disorder is more probable.

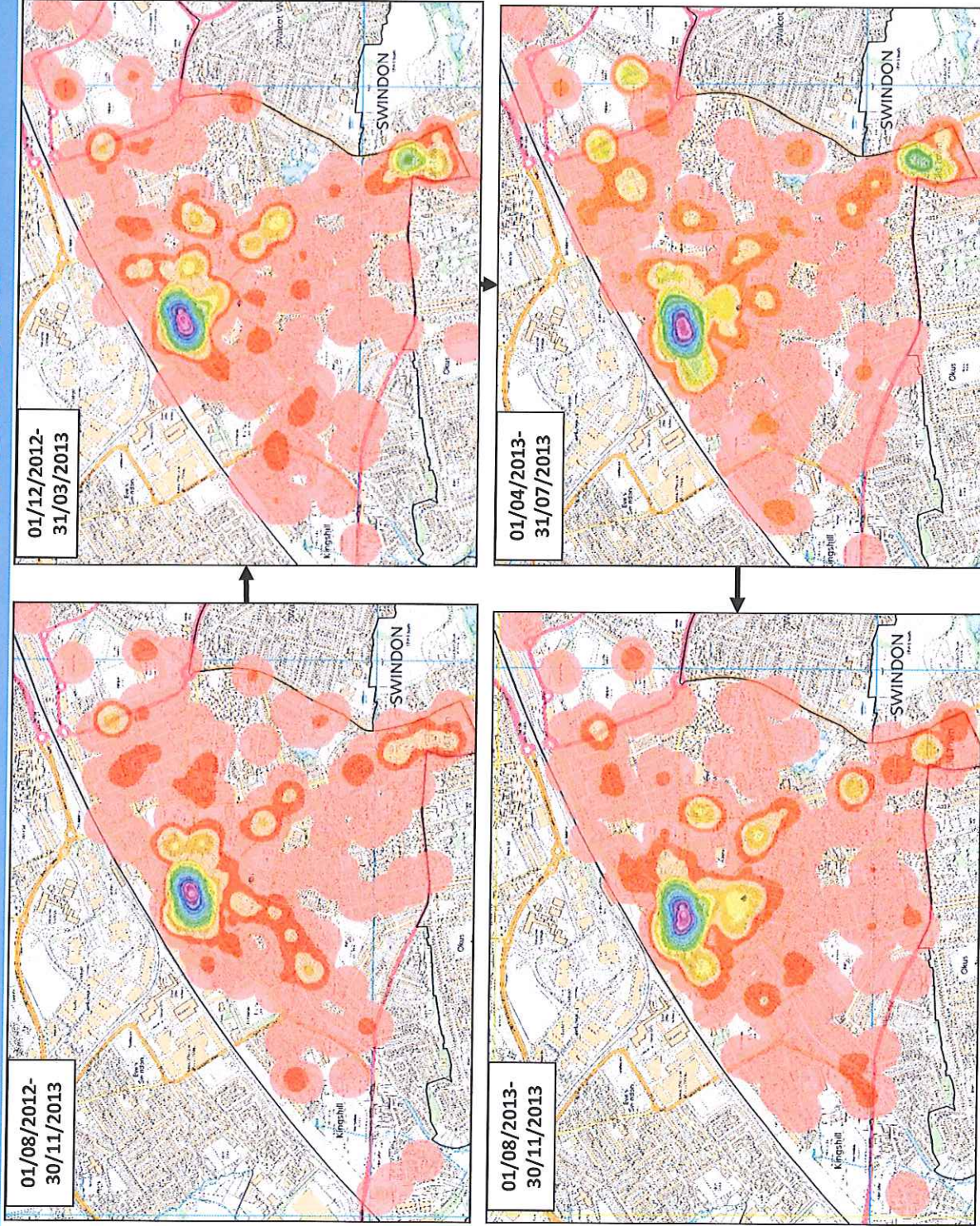




# Hot Spot Mapping

The adjacent hotspot maps show the distribution of NTE incidents within the DT sector for the 12 months prior to the opening of the Brunel Rooms and the 4 months since. The Brunel Rooms is denoted by the symbol :

A clear hot spot can be seen to be emerging in the area of the Brunel Rooms in the 4 months since it opened suggesting that the presence of the venue has had an impact on NTE related incidents in the area. However, when compared to the long term hotspots surrounding other venues such as those in Fleet Square and Victoria Road the impact of the Brunel Rooms is relatively minor.







# Havelock Square Incidents

- The emergence of a hotspot in the vicinity of the Brunel Rooms is corroborated when the top 10 streets for NTE incident for the 4 months prior to the venue opening are compared to the following 4 months.

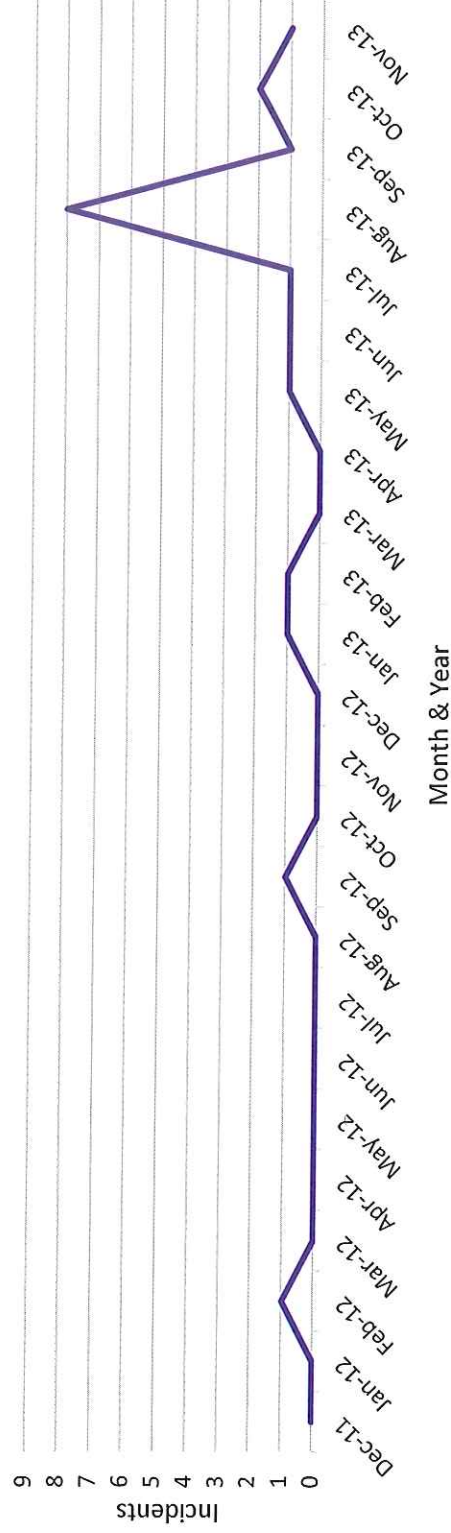

Havelock Square was in joint 15<sup>th</sup> place with 3 recorded incidents for the period 01/04/2013-31/07/2013, rising to joint 4<sup>th</sup> place with 11 recorded incidents for the period 01/08/2013-30/11/2013. The below graph shows the incident data for Havelock Square by month for the whole data period. The "spike" in August 2013 may be attributed to the opening of the Brunel Rooms but it is noted that since this initial increase, likely to be a cause of a large number of people wanting to visit a "new" venue (the novelty factor), disorder in this area has decreased. Thus it cannot be said that the Brunel Rooms is having a significant impact on the area and it is recommended that analysis be repeated in 6 months time in order for more data to be available.

## SUMMARY OF INCIDENTS

### **Management and staffing issues at the premises**

1. 01/08/13 On the opening night some training issues were picked up at the venue by licensing checks conducted by Licensing Officers.
  - 2045hours licensing officers attend venue to walk around. Whilst there bar staff have been asked about training in the Amphi bar. They said they had been trained in relation to fire safety, bar work, drunkenness and underage. They were asked if they supplied drinking water which is only supplied in bottles for a charge which is in breach of a mandatory condition. They were also asked about how they contact door staff for assistance the procedure was established after some clarification.
  - Informed by security that the smoking area was going to be limited to 40 persons and no drinks allowed outside to help stop people lingering.
  - 2345 hours walk around premises. Doorstaff were hard to spot within the premises due to the low lighting and the black jackets. Suggested that the yellow tabards are used inside.
  - 23.45hours. Observed that the area leading to the smoking area was very busy and uncontrolled a scuffle broke out in front of us. There was no attempt to limit people moving into the area by door staff and it was very congested up there. People were also going out there with their drinks.

2. 02/08/13 02.20hours

Licensing officer 6454 Kalyuka made a final check of the premises before ending duty. Whilst stood talking to a member of doorstaff in relation to numbers at the premises, number of ejections etc They had recently dealt with a disorder as a result there were a number of groups in the area with approx 6 doorstaff gathered at the entrance. A female was seen to throw a barrier at doorstaff shouting at them.

Whilst stood at the entrance a male known to be Aaron WOOLFORD the promotions manager informed the member of doorstaff and I that he was wasted on Wednesday night at the premises and that he wasn't that bad tonight. The member of door staff highlighted that he probably did not want to continue with this line of conversation to the licensing officer and that he probably shouldn't be drinking whilst at work. Mr Woolford ignored this and advised that it was a perk of the job and that "he wasn't that pissed tonight".



3. 02/08/13 02.40hours

Licensing Officer 6454 Kalyinka advised the head doorman that he may want to bring down other door staff from inside depending on numbers left due to the disorder that had taken place outside the premises. The doorstaff indicated that the disorder was to do with the family that had been in private room and had actually left the building an hour ago but had been hanging around the premises outside for a considerable time. It was discussed that dispersal policy on the licence was to be used to help prevent incidents such as this. It also led to the question as to how the private rooms are managed.

#### 4. POL-20130805-0011 00.53

Jason Ranford one of the company directors and managers has been abusing door staff at another town centre licensed premises. Police were called in order to deal with Jason Ranford who was given words of advice to stay away from the premises.

An email was received from the licensed premises manager and detailed on the storm log.

*Email regarding incident on Sunday 04/08/13*

*On Sunday night Jason Ranford approached the front door to be told by doorstaff that he was unable to come in as on pubwatch. He said ok and knew he was. He was then stood outside for while giving doorstaff abuse. Then two guys came up to him and starting arguing with him about money Jason owed them. I advised them that it was not the time or place sort this out. The guys walked off. Jason then continued to make threats to doorstaff and be abusive. he was also abusive to customers leaving. I asked him to move away. he ignored me. After some time he was then on the phone telling them to come down to casbah and sort out doorstaff. I had enough and asked doorstaff to go inside and call 101 and have him removed from front door. When the doorstaff came back out Jason was still there saying stuff about his mum. and what time was she expecting him round. The police arrived. We explained what was going on. I was told they had nothing to arrest him on. I just wanted him moved away. At this point he was in the kebab shop next door. The police went and spoke to him and then advised us that when he had finished his food he was going home. But told police we had it wrong and he was not on pubwatch, it had been over turned. I told police that he was still on the ban. The police then told us bring it up with licensing. They then went and sat in the car. Jason then came and sat outside still shouting abuse but the police were sat in the car and did not hear this. The police stayed around for about 30 minutes. Advise me if he causes anymore problems to ring it in again. After sometime he went in a taxi.*

*I feel this is unacceptable behaviour and totally uncalled for. It is also a breach of ban. I sent an email to paul on monday morning but ban breach was not discussed at pub watch.*

5. POL-20130925-23 03.59

The Brunel Rooms had an after party for the Swindon v Chelsea game. Nathan and staff left at 2am leaving the three directors Helene Simpkins, Paula Harris and Jason Ranford with friends and associates. An incident has occurred inside the premises between a group who were ejected via the smoking area by Jason Ranford. This incident has continued outside of the premises and a call was made by Brunel Security to Police due to the disorder outside of the premises. Upon police arrival a male has complained that he was assaulted and money taken off him. The premises is only able to be open until 01.30 to members of the public. Nathan Hatter the DPS was spoken to and told that this is not acceptable particularly when police end up being called and have to deal as a consequence. CCTV provided of the incident by the DPS

CCTV viewed and a scuffle is seen inside at 3.29 the individuals are taken out into the smoking area where Ranford is seen to push them through the exit at the top of the ramp and then close the door behind him. There is a lot of pushing and shoving involved in the incident. It is noted that there were a number of people on the premises who appear to have been drinking.

Email from PC Hastings

Hi Sian,

Jason RANFORD threw a private party last night and didn't have any door staff on duty. He was letting people out of the top entrance and making them walk down the ramp to the annoyance of Brunel security. They are making a formal complaint about him in the morning.

There was a large fight which started inside the venue and spilled out on to the ramp. The fight on the ramp has been caught on CCTV, however this was not available to us immediately as they were having technical difficulties. Details of the people involved were taken. 2 bar staff were spoken to who stated there were no security staff on this evening. Brunel security can also confirm that.

A couple of the people we stopped also stated there were no security staff and they had to intervene when a male started kicking off and throwing glasses and bottles at people, they said RANFORD couldn't handle it and was in a flighty mood.

We are not sure on how many people were there but apparently it was advertised on face book. We were told that Swindon Town club members were there and also STFC fans. The club still had people in at 4am this morning.

We have asked Brunel security to down load the CCTV so we can review it before we take any further action. There were no complaints from the people that had been injured but they may change there mind when sober! All people involved were heavily intoxicated to say the least!

6. 25/09/13 I was made aware of Aaron Woolfords Facebook page. Where a poster for the brunel rooms has been stuck onto a Police van. Nathan Hatter DPS was made aware of this and advised that it be taken down.





## **7. 54130094396 04/10/13 00.54 hours**

Officers have attended a disturbance at the Brunel Rooms ( a male was arrested for being drunk and disorderly.) On arrival at custody the male was seen to have sustained an injury to his left cheek bone with some large swelling. The male was conveyed to GWH. CCTV enquiries with Brunel Security show that Jason Ranford a manager at the Brunel Rooms has assaulted the male. Jason Ranford was arrested and bailed for the offence. Jason Ranford then pleaded guilty to the assault whilst at court being dealt with for other matters and was sentenced to 4 weeks imprisonment on top of further sentences.

The doorstaff log did not record accurately what occurred during this incident and does not mention any assault by Jason Ranford on the customer despite several members of door staff being present and involved.

### **PC Shanklins Statement**

I am A Police Constable based at Gablecross Police Station employed by Wiltshire Police.

On Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2013 I was on duty and in full uniform in company of PC 2600 BARKER. During the evening I was dealing with a male XXXXXXXXXXXX who I had arrested for being drunk and disorderly outside the BRUNEL ROOMS NIGHTCLUB, SWINDON. Upon arrival at Gablecross Custody it was clear that xxxxxxxx had an injury to his left eye and cheek bone. xxxxxxxx had a swollen left cheek bone which had swollen to about the size of half the size of a ping pong ball.

Xxxxxxxx was taken to Great Western Hospital by myself and PC BARKER whereby he was left at A&E to be treated.

At 0300 hours I attended BRUNEL SECURITY Control Room whereby myself and PC BARKER viewed footage from their camera's showing an assault by a male I know called Jason RANFORD bn 4-8-1986. RANFORD I have met several times before and know he is the manager of The BRUNEL ROOMS NIGHTCLUB, SWINDON.

I watched the footage on a monitor and could clearly see RANFORD outside the doors of the BRUNEL ROOMS wearing a jacket with the BRUNEL ROOMS printed on the back. I could see a male who I had dealt with several hours earlier by the name of xxxxxxxxxxxx. xxxxxx could be seen being ejected out of the club and restrained on the floor by several door staff. RANFORD could be standing over and getting involved in the incident. I could see that xxxxxxxx gets up to his feet and is then grabbed by RANFORD and then punches xxxxxx to his face and then holds onto MORRISONS chest area whilst having right fist clenched in the air ready to punch him again. RANFORD appeared very aggressive in

his body language. xxxxx is then seen walking off away from the club and then returns whereby RANFORD pushes him again and is taken to the floor by other bouncers. I could see RANFORD stamp on the floor very close to xxxxxx hands, I could not tell if his hand was stamped on. I know that RANFORD is not meant to be getting involved into any of the incidents at BRUNEL ROOMS as he is not an SIA badge holder due to his violence. RANFORD could be seen on the CCTV intervening in the incident. There were sufficient bouncers to deal at the scene but RANFORD continues to get involved. Finally I see RANFORD push and check xxxxxx as he returns to the front of the club and RANFORD then pushes xxxxxx against the wall, punches xxxxxx in the face and bring his knee up to xxxxxx face. The whole incident lasted 12-15 minutes on camera.

He was extremely intoxicated and when he was asked to stop he stated "I WORK FOR THE BRUNEL ROOMS, I CAN DO WHAT I FUCKING WANT." At the time it was not practicable to issue him with a pnd as were dealing with something else but I intend to ticket him retrospectively when I come back on Wednesday for the next set.

I thought that I would make you aware of the incident as I understand that WOOLFORD works for the Brunel Rooms.

#### PC Winton's Witness Statement

I am a serving police officer based in Swindon, Wiltshire and I was on uniformed patrol in the town centre between the hours of 2000-0600hrs on the 02 November 2013 in company with SC 4161 WINTON.

We were tasked to attend Havelock Square by the Brunel Rooms at approximately 0430hrs to wait with a vehicle that was going to be collected by Greenmeadow. At approximately 0448hrs I saw a male climb over a barrier from Commercial Road to enter Havelock Square and walk towards the car park. I saw the male walk under the shelter of the car park, which was the spiral exit for vehicles and face the wall. I saw the male move his hands around in front of him then I could clearly hear him



urinating against the wall. He was approximately 15metres away from me but there was street lighting so I could see him relatively clearly.

When SC 4161 WINTON and I approached the male and told him to stop he turned around and said "FUCK OFF". I could see him doing up the flies and belt on his trousers which confirmed my suspicions that he had been urinating. I could also see a damp patch that appeared to fresh on the wall where he had been standing. He was swaying on his feet and I believe he was intoxicated as I could smell liquor on his person. I asked him why he had been urinating outside and he said "I WORK FOR THE BRUNEL ROOMS, I CAN DO WHAT I FUCKING WANT." I asked him to stop swearing and he replied "I CAN SWEAR AS MUCH AS I FUCKING WANT."

SC 4161 WINTON asked the male who he was and he stated that his name was Aaron WOOLFORD bn 15/08/78. He also said "I LIVE AT 12 WESSEX COURT, YOU CAN SEND ME A TICKET FOR PISSING, I DON'T CARE."

At this point a taxi arrived and Mr WOOLFORD climbed into the vehicle and it drove off so it was not practicable for a penalty notice for disorder to be issued at that time. With this in mind SC 4161 WINTON contacted our control room and passed over the details about what had occurred with a view to issuing a ticket at a later date.

## Statement of PC Millers

"I am Police Constable 2552 Christopher MILLER of Wiltshire Police currently stationed at Gablecross Police Station attached to Response Team 2A of WD Division.

On Friday the 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2013 I was on duty in uniform in company with PC 2577 REEVES



and allocated the call sign DT04.

At approximately 0225hrs the same day we were directed to attend the front of the Brunel Rooms in Havelock Square following reports of a disorder at the location. On our arrival I instantly noticed a group of approximately 15 people, a mix of male and females. The group I noticed were being extremely hostile towards Door staff at the Brunel Rooms.

My attention was then drawn to two door staff who were restraining a male I know now to be XX. I heard XXX say "THATS MY FUCKING FRIEND YOU FUCKING CUNTS" I noticed that XXX was being restrained by the door staff, I could see that XXX was agitated. I approached XXX and attempted to speak with him about what was happening, I could smell intoxicating liquor on XXX breath and despite being restrained he was unsteady on his feet. XXX would not speak with me and continued to shout and swear. I took hold of XXX left arm and said " CALM DOWN BEFORE YOU GET ARRESTED BUDDY " XXX replied "YOU FUCKING CUNT ITS MY MATES PARTY GET THE FUCK OFF ME "

I approached XXX and attempted to speak with him about what was happening, I could smell intoxicating liquor on XXX breath and despite being restrained he was unsteady on his feet. XXX would not speak with me and continued to shout and swear. I took hold of XXX left arm and said " CALM DOWN BEFORE YOU GET ARRESTED BUDDY " XXX replied "YOU FUCKING CUNT ITS MY MATES PARTY GET THE FUCK OFF ME "

Due to XXX drunken state, and level of disorderly behaviour I arrested XXX for being Drunk & Disorderly. I applied my handcuff to XXX left wrist and took him to the floor to allow for a secure restraint and I applied the second cuff to his right wrist in a rear stack position

At 0230hours I said to XXX "I AM ARRESTING YOU FOR BEING DRUNK AND DISORDERLY IN A PUBLIC PLACE. YOU DO NOT HAVE TO SAY ANYTHING BUT IT MAY HARM YOUR DEFENCE IF YOU DO NOT MENTION WHEN QUESTIONED SOMETHING WHICH YOU LATER RELY ON IN COURT, ANYTHING YOU DO SAY MAY BE GIVEN IN EVIDENCE. YOUR ARREST IS NECESSARY TO PREVENT HARM OR INJURY TO PERSONS AND TO ALLOW FOR A PROMPT AND EFFECTIVE INVESTIGATION." XXX replied "GET THE FUCK OFF ME YOU CUNT".

With the assistance of PC 1677 WILTSHIRE I escorted XXX to the rear of my marked VITO van and placed him in the cage. PC 1677 WILTSHIRE searched XXX and placed his personal property in a latex glove and handed it to me as well as a black I-Phone.

As I walked to the front of the vehicle a white male, aged early 50's wearing a white shirt with



clenched fists coming straight towards me, the male appeared extremely angry, I told the male to "STOP, GET BACK " he continued towards me so I used a two handed check and pushed the male back to create space between us, as I have done this the latex glove and mobile phone fell from my hand onto the floor. Eventually the male backed away so I started to look for the property and phone, I found the latex glove but could not locate the phone. A female I did not know said to me "ITS OK HIS AUNTY HAS IT "

I transported XXX in the rear of the van, as we entered Commercial Road XXX was shouting " MY CUFFS ARE TIGHT I CANNOT FEEL MY HANDS " I stopped the vehicle and went to the cage and opened the rear door to loosen XXX cuffs. XXX said "TAKE THESE CUFFS OFF AND I AM GOING TO FUCKING KILL YOU" Due to the treat and XXX level of aggression I updated the Police control room and made best time to custody to get assistance with the handcuffs in a safe environment.

At custody XXX continued to behave in a drunk and disorderly manner and the booking in process had to be postponed and XXX taken straight to his cell.

Throughout the incident XXX would not calm down and listen to reason and continued to display a high level of strength and aggression.

#### Offence Summary by PS1868 ANGER SUMMARY:

Officers were tasked to a disorder at Brunel rooms. XXXXXXXX was detained on the floor by door staff and continued his drunk and disorderly behaviour. He was arrested by 2552.

At the time of arrival there were approximately 40-60 people outside the club. Door staff were dispersing various people. XXX taken to the van parked closest to the rear door and placed in the rear cage. Van is blocked in by taxi's. Numerous family members approach the van and request that XXX is de-arrested. Attempts made to disperse family as XXX is kicking off in the van. One female who i now know as XXXXXXXX asked to try and calm him down, side door opened to allow her to speak with him through the van but she climbs into rear seat area of van. XXXXX then refuses to leave the van, stating "FUCK OFF HE'S MY SON, FUCKING LET HIM OUT NOW, I'M HIS MOTHER". She is extremely intoxicated and aggressive with me. She is asked continually to leave the van but refuses and becomes more aggressive and pointing her finger in my face and an attemot to provoke and poke me in the face. No contact made. I then remove her by holding her arm and pull her towards the door. As I do she comes forward and trips over a box of Police equipment in the back causing her to fall from the van. She is prevented from hitting the floor with her upper body by myself and 2552 who catch her fall. XXXX then throws her mobile phone and a polivce blue lamp in my direction. She is arrested for obstruct and assault Police and cautioned. HC to rear and detained against van as its locked.

Whilst we are waiting for 1118 to open the van, numerous family members approach us crying stating that the female has just lost her son, stating that her son was killed and blaming the Police.



XXXXXX placed in the van.

More family members including "older" family members approach officers and beg officers to release XXXX, all apologising for her drunken state and stating she is bereaving from her sons recent death. Family members promise to disperse if she is let go.

XXXX is no trace on PNC.

Due to the information regarding her bereavement, previous good character, family members apologies, agreement to disperse and lack of resources available, i decide to de-arrest in order to maintain resources and a visible presence in the area due to the volume of people present and the clubs closing hours.XXXXXXX can be dealt with slow time if required.

### Interview of Offender 03/08/13

Rights given, caution explained, knowledge checked and understood. At the start of the interview xxxxx was advised that he had been arrested for an assault on xxxxxxxxx. xxxxxxxx was then further arrested for assaulting xxx.

xxxx was asked to account for where he was at 0300 hours on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2013. xxxxx confirmed that he had been out in Swindon Town Centre at that time however stated that he couldn't recall how the incident started or much about the incident itself. xxxxx stated that the only memory he had was rolling around on the floor and being punched to the side of a head, which he believed was by a female. xxxxx stated that he couldn't recall much other than that.

xxxxx explained that he had gone out drinking with friends between 2200 - 2300 hours on the evening of Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2013. xxxxx advised his riends he went out with were xxxxxx and a male he only

knows as xxxx, and when they went into town they went to the Brunel Rooms. xxxx stated he thought he only went to the Brunel Rooms last night as he couldn't recall going anywhere else. xxxxx stated that he did recall that he left the Brunel Rooms with an old friend that he hadn't seen in years called xxxxx explained he couldn't recall xxxx surname however described him as a white male, tall, skinny with brown hair aged about 20 years. Whilst out xxxxx advised he consumed 6 Brandy and cokes which were a mixture of singles and doubles, and prior to going out he had consumed 2 Brandy and cokes at home. xxxxs stated that he hadn't had a meal before going out and that he hadn't eaten for a couple of weeks as he had been living on protein shakes. xxxx advised that this was not a normal amount for him to drink as he doesn't normally go out and the alcohol effected him quite a bit and stated that this was the reason that he couldn't recall anything. On a scale of 1 - 10, 1 being sober and 10 being completely drunk, xxxxx placed himself as an 8. xxxx described himself as a tall black male, 6'3" in height with short curly black hair wearing a green and blue striped horizontal top, black jeans and red trainers.

xxx was advised of the background of the allegation in relation to how he came across the group and how the altercation started. xxxxx stated he didn't know how the altercation started. He could remember being arrested and could recall being hit by either a girl or a boy and being on the floor but could not recall much more than that. xxxx stated he could recall there being 3 - 4 of them but could not describe any of the persons he had had an altercation with.

Allegations of xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx were put to xxxx. xxxx stated that the allegations were a lie, especially the allegation in relation to him assaulting xxxxxxxxxxxx. xxxx stated that he would never hit a girl in his life and that xxxxxx was definately lying. xxxx stated that he did not strike xxxxx round the back of the head and stated that if he had of done he would have broken his hands in doing this. xxxx stated that someone hit him around the head and he recalled rolling around on the floor being assaulted. xxxx denied that punched xxxx to the head and forehead and stated that xxxxx was lying, he was 100% sure that he would never hit a girl and if he had struck her to the head as described she would have been on the floor. xxxx was challenged that he couldn't be sure of what he did as he couldn't recall his actions, xxxx agreed with this stating "NO, I DON'T KNOW, I NEED TO SEE THE CCTV, I DON'T REMEMBER NONE OF THAT AND I DEFINATELY WOULD NOT HIT A GIRL".

The only account xxxxdid accept was xxxx account of placing him in a headlock, xxxxstated that this must have happened because that explained how he ended up on the floor, however could not recall this and only accepted this explanation and not the remainder of xxxx account. xxxx disputed the accounts and stated that they were lying and that he wanted to see the CCTV. xxxx pointed out that the injuries on xxxx were convenient in that they were in her hair where they couldn't be seen and stated that she was lying. In relation to xxxxs account of xxxx squeezing his knuckles xxxx stated it was "BOLLOCKS".



In relation to the comments made xxx stated he may have used the word "PUSSY" at some point but he would never have used the words "WHITE TRASH" stating that this was "HILL BILLY" talk and he didn't talk like that.

xxx was advised that the I/P's were all well known to each other and had no reason to corroborate each other's account, xxxx again stated that he would need to see the CCTV.

xxxx disagreed that his top was turquoise and stated that it was green, and stated when asked that he was right handed. xxxxs advised that he doesn't get aggressive when he drinks.

At the end of the interview xxxx showed his knuckles on both his hands which were clear, xxx then pointed out a reddening lump about the size of a 20p above his right eyebrow, which xxxx stated was where he was struck when he was on the floor and that the injury was not caused by him falling to the floor.

xxxxx confirmed that he would be happy to take part in an identification procedure if required.

## **Statement of PC CANAVAN**

I am Police Constable 2491 David Canavan currently stationed at Gablecross Police station SWINDON.

At 01:02hrs on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2013 I was in company with PC 2567 Baldock in full police uniform in the Havelock Square area of Swindon. My colleague and I were monitoring the public entering and leaving the Brunel Rooms Swindon.

My attention was drawn to a male in a group of females, he had just left the club and was rather rowdy. Although he was not being abusive at this point, the male was unsteady on his feet and required the support of his friends. I would describe the male as white, approximately five foot ten

inches tall. He was wearing a white t-shirt along with dark jeans. Following this, the male started to become abusive towards the group, he was rather loud with his abusive language. This causing other members of the public to look in his general direction. I approached the male and warned him regarding his abusive behaviour, and advised him to desist. On speaking to the male, he identified himself as xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx the male was slurring his words and I could smell alcohol emanating from his breath. I formed the opinion the male was drunk.

Following on, the male then started again shouting "FUCK YOU, THATS MY COUSIN YOU FUCKING TWAT" At that point the male was being disorderly and was obviously under the influence. Therefore, I approached the male for a second time and applied a top cuff to his left wrist, while at the same time I informed the male he was under arrest. The male started to resist, tensing his left arm. Using force approved techniques I took the male to the floor and cuffed him to the rear. I stated to the male he was under arrest for being drunk and disorderly in public place Contrary to section 91 (1) criminal justice act 1967. I stated " YOU DO NOT HAVE TO SAY ANYTHING BUT IT MAY HARM YOUR DEFENCE IF YOU DO NOT MENTION WHEN QUESTIONED SOMETHING WHICH YOU LATER RELY ON IN COURT. ANYTHING YOU DO SAY MAY BE GIVEN IN EVIDENCE" I informed him the necessity of the arrest was to prevent harm and injury due to his agitated demeanour. The male replied in slurred speech "I HAVENT DONE FUCKING NOTHING WRONG" The male became emotional and was crying and continued to swear stating "YOU FUCKING IDIOT, I HAVE NOT DONE NOTHING WRONG"

The male was placed in the rear of the marked police vehicle and escorted to police custody. At 01:38hrs on the aforementioned date the grounds and necessity were outlined to PS BARKER who in turn authorised his detention.

I had no further dealings.

The description matches the female that thought her phone had been stolen and was so drunk she could not recall the nights events.

### **Investigator entry**

xxxx attended her scheduled appointment and clarified the incident occurred on the 10/08 not the 03/08. xxxxx reported she had been out for the evening with her boyfriend xxxxx and was staying at his house in Old Town. Unfortunately xxxxx cannot remember much about the evening after she got to the Brunel Rooms but at 0050 she has been told she rang a friend from her mobile hysterical and upset. Her friends could not understand what she was saying and then there are two paid taxi fares at 0055 of £16.06p which have been made using her phone which is now missing. The following morning xxxxx woke up with her boyfriend as normal. She has spoken to xxx but he cannot remember anything happening and they walked home at the end of the night together. He has been too drunk and not remembered correctly in the past.

I have checked found property and the xxxx mobile phone has not been handed in. I have added the IMEI numberxxxxxxxxxxxxx onto the NMPR database. Having checked police storm logs I have found POL-20130810-0010. A concerned member of the public called the police at 0025 10/08 to report a very drunk intoxicated girl lying in the road before getting into a black cab xxxxxx. The girl matches the description of xxxx who was wearing a xx xxxdot dress. I have made enquiries with SBC Taxi Licencing 466208 and spoke with team leader Mike SHEARS who has given a business contact number for the owner xxxxxxx.

xxxxxwas quite shocked and believed this girl lying in the road must have been her. She was also aware she might very well have lost or misplaced her phone anytime after paying and leaving the taxi. Nevertheless I have still contacted and spoken to xxxxxx who reported no phone had been found. xxxx would however still like to query the double fare so I have given her the number for SBC Taxi Licencing. Suitable advice has still been given to xxxxx about the level of her intoxication and the vulnerable position it places her in. Closed for consideration as UNDETECTED pending further information coming to light.

A report was made of a disorder occurring near to Regent Circus and involved a group of known males who had been into the Brunel Rooms that evening. All the males that were involved in the disorder and that had been to the venue are banned on pubwatch for being involved in disorders in other licensed premises.

An intelligence report was received describing the incident.

In the early hours of Monday 26th August morning(approx 4am) there was a large disorder outside Rudis bar. The group concerned had been in the Brunel Rooms prior and are all on pubwatch banning orders concerning a previous disorder. They also were in possession of large bottles of champagne, brandy etc which they got out of Brunel somehow and were clearly intent on using them. The names below are the persons involved. These individuals would not get in anywhere else due to there previous behaviours/reputations. Introductions, reminded of legal rights and caution explained which xxxx indicated he understood.

Arrested for an offence of affray by LCI 8368 at 1325 hours and cautioned.

xxxx when asked provided the following account. he was in the Brunel Rooms and when he came out he saw his old friend xxx (He later confirmed this was his cousin), they chatted and he was intending to walk home to xxxxxxxx was racially abused by a man and he chased him intending to get a look at his face and then report it. he was about 10 -15 metres behind him. That was it he didn't know about anything else including any knife. He went onto say that the Brunel Rooms had a scanner which he



had to go through so if he had a knife it would have showed up. xxxprobably had it on him outside. he just followed xxx into the car park as it wasn't on his way home to Henry Street. John stated xxxwas arguing with someone outside the club but he didn't know who. xxx was trouble and that's why he didn't hang around with him and he just wanted a quiet life. He had pulled xxxaway from the man he was arguing with outside the club and accepted this is why they had gone a different way.

When they got into Iceland car park another unknown male who had obviously heard him talking told him "Fuck off back to your own country you foreign cunt". This had made him get very angry, with the drink he had consumed 10 -11 pints so he chased after the man intending to look at him but the man was too quick. He did admit to shouting "Don't let me fucking get you" at the male and accepted this would have scared anybody nearby. he did this because he was so angry at what the man had said to him.

xxx completely denied having the knife, seeing anyone else with the knife or even knowing about the knife and stated his forensics would not be on the knife.

Witness accounts put to him and he confirmed the descriptions given matched him and xxxx, xxx being the one in shorts.

Account summarised and he wished to add nothing.

Jason RANFORD threw a private party last night and didn't have any door staff on duty. He was letting people out of the top entrance and making them walk down the ramp to the annoyance of Brunel security. They are making a formal complaint about him in the morning.

There was a large fight which started inside the venue and spilled out on to the ramp. The fight on the ramp has been caught on CCTV, however this was not available to us immediately as they were having technical difficulties. Details of the people involved were taken. 2 bar staff were spoken to who stated there were no security staff on this evening. Brunel security can also confirm that.

A couple of the people we stopped also stated there were no security staff and they had to intervene when a male started kicking off and throwing glasses and bottles at people, they said RANFORD couldn't handle it and was in a flighty mood.

We are not sure on how many people were there but apparently it was advertised on face book. We were told that Swindon Town club members were there and also STFC fans. The club still had people in at 4am this morning.

We have asked Brunel security to down load the CCTV so we can review it before we take any further action. There were no complaints from the people that had been injured but they may change there mind when sober! All people involved were heavily intoxicated to say the least!

At Custody it was clear that XXXXXX had an injury to his left cheek bone, he was taken to GWH whereby he was released and issued a ticket by PC SHANKLIN.

Officers have attended a disturbance at Brunel Rooms (as detailed above) and a male was arrested for being drunk and disorderly. On arrival at custody the male was seen to have sustained an injury to his left cheek bone with some large swelling. The male was conveyed to GWH. CCTV enquiries with Brunel Security show that Jason Ranford a manager at the Brunel Rooms has assaulted the male. Jason Ranford was arrested and bailed for the offence. Jason Ranford then pleaded guilty to the assault whilst at court being dealt with for other matters and was sentenced to 4 weeks imprisonment on top of further sentences.

The doorstaff log did not record accurately what occurred during this incident and does not mention any assault by Jason Ranford on the customer despite several members of door staff being present and involved.

#### PC Shanklins Statement

I am A Police Constable based at Gablecross Police Station employed by Wiltshire Police.

On Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2013 I was on duty and in full uniform in company of PC 2600 BARKER. During the evening I was dealing with a male XXXXXXXXXXXX who I had arrested for being drunk and disorderly outside the BRUNEL ROOMS NIGHTCLUB, SWINDON. Upon arrival at Gablecross Custody it was clear that xxxxxxxx had an injury to his left eye and cheek bone. xxxxxxxx had a swollen left cheek bone which had swollen to about the size of half the size of a ping pong ball.

Xxxxxxxx was taken to Great Western Hospital by myself and PC BARKER whereby he was left at A&E to be treated.

At 0300 hours I attended BRUNEL SECURITY Control Room whereby myself and PC BARKER viewed footage from their camera's showing an assault by a male I know called Jason RANFORD bn 4-8-1986. RANFORD I have met several times before and know he is the manager of The BRUNEL ROOMS NIGHTCLUB, SWINDON.

I watched the footage on a monitor and could clearly see RANFORD outside the doors of the BRUNEL ROOMS wearing a jacket with the BRUNEL ROOMS printed on the back. I could see a male who I had dealt with several hours earlier by the name of xxxxxxxxxxxx. xxxxxx could be seen being ejected out of the club and restrained on the floor by several door staff. RANFORD could be standing over and getting involved in the incident. I could see that xxxxxxxx gets up to his feet and is then grabbed by RANFORD and then punches xxxxxx to his face and then holds onto MORRISONS chest area whilst having right fist clenched in the air ready to punch him again. RANFORD appeared very aggressive in

his body language. xxxxx is then seen walking off away from the club and then returns whereby RANFORD pushes him again and is taken to the floor by other bouncers. I could see RANFORD stamp on the floor very close to xxxxxxx hands, I could not tell if his hand was stamped on. I know that RANFORD is not meant to be getting involved into any of the incidents at BRUNEL ROOMS as he is not an SIA badge holder due to his violence. RANFORD could be seen on the CCTV intervening in the incident. There were sufficient bouncers to deal at the scene but RANFORD continues to get involved. Finally I see RANFORD push and check xxxxxxx as he returns to the front of the club and RANFORD then pushes xxxxxx against the wall, punches xxxxxx in the face and bring his knee up to xxxxxxx face. The whole incident lasted 12-15 minutes on camera.

xxxxxx was in Brunel Rooms nightclub VIP area with friends when he has been struck to the head twice by a bottle. It is unknown why this has occurred and the only description of offenders were given by his friends. There were two males involved one described as wearing a white scarf with a skeleton pattern on it. xxxxxxxx has been treated by door staff and eventually taken to hospital. Police have arrived while he is being treated and had to

deal with a number of highly aggressive people in the area and as a result were unable to collect full details from witnesses as most were uncooperative and intoxicated. CCTV has been viewed in the club and searches made for possible offenders but neither were positive and as a result it is not possible to identify offender/offenders.

At hospital where he has been escorted by officers xxxxx has declined to make a complaint and confirmed he does not know or be able to identify the offenders.

As a result there are no further lines of enquiry and no evidence to present from the aggrieved. No arrests were made in connection to this assault.

Officers were at the premises dealing with the above assault. They were trying to keep customers away from the area the paramedic was working on the injured party of the assault but a male refused to leave the area and was told several times to go away. In the end the male had to be arrested for being drunk and disorderly.

**PC 2580 Owers Statement**

On SUNDAY 3 NOVEMBER 2013 I was on duty in full uniform in company with Police Sergeant 1623 SPARGO on mobile patrol in SWINDON TOWN CENTRE. At approximately 0315 hours we attended THE BRUNEL ROOMS, 1 HAVELOCK SQUARE, NEW TOWN, SWINDON following a call for assistance from police units already at the scene of an assault. We arrived at the scene shortly afterwards where I saw a male sat on the ground opposite THE BRUNEL ROOMS being treated by ambulance staff. I would describe the atmosphere at the scene as very tense. There were numerous police officers and security staff trying to keep members of the public from interfering with the ambulance staff and trying to keep the situation calm.

As I was stood protecting the scene I noticed PC 2530 WINTER walking towards a male who was stood by the wall close to where the paramedics were working. I now know this male to be Mr XXXXXXXXXX. I heard PC WINTER say words to the effect of "I TOLD YOU TO GO AROUND, GO AWAY". XXXXXX started arguing with PC WINTER however I could not hear what he was saying. For at least a minute I heard PC WINTER tell XXXXXX numerous times to move away however XXXXXX ignored him and continued to argue. PC WINTER then took hold of XXXXXX and began to push him away from the scene. I saw XXXXXX resist him and at this point I moved towards them. At 0325 hours I heard PC WINTER say "YOU ARE UNDER ARREST FOR BEING DRUNK AND DISORDERLY YOU DO NOT HAVE TO SAY ANYTHING BUT IT MAY HARM YOUR DEFENCE IF YOU DO NOT MENTION WHEN QUESTIONED SOMETHING WHICH YOU LATER RELY ON IN COURT, ANYTHING YOU DO SAY MAY BE GIVEN IN EVIDENCE. YOUR ARREST IS NECESSARY TO PREVENT INJURY TO ANY PERSON". He then started trying to apply what looked like an arm restraint. I took hold of XXXXXX left arm and began to force it behind his back with the intention of placing handcuffs on him. I was aware that PC WINTER was doing something similar with XXXXXX other arm however XXXXXX strongly resisted us, tensing his arms out straight and pulling away from us. With the aid of other officers and staff from THE BRUNEL ROOMS we took XXXXXX to the ground in a controlled manner. At this point I managed to force XXXXXX left arm behind his back and handcuffed him in the rear stack position. I double locked the handcuffs and checked them for tightness. We assisted XXXXXX to his feet and began to walk him through the town centre towards the POLICE CENTRE POINT. On the way there I loosened XXXXXX handcuffs after he complained they were too tight and I checked them again for tightness. I could smell alcohol



on his breath and he slurred his words as he spoke. He eyes were also glazed and I therefore formed the opinion he was drunk.

Once we reached the POLICE CENTRE POINT, PC WINTER told XXXXX that if he calmed down, he would issue him with a section 27 direction to leave the area and he would be de-arrested. XXXXXX would not listen to what PC WINTER was saying and continued to be very argumentative. He was subsequently placed in the back of a marked police vehicle where I transported him to SWINDON GABLECROSS CUSTODY in company with Special Constable 4205 LANG. We arrived at GABLECROSS CUSTODY at 0350 hours.

Following this incident I am aware that PC WINTER has attended the Accident and Emergency Department at SWINDON GREAT WESTERN HOSPITAL and has been told his hand has been broken. He is unable to write a statement or issue the appropriate ticket because of this.

Email from PC Owers describing levels of intoxication and confirmation of the offenders attendance at the Brunel Rooms.

Hi Sian

I remember asking xxxxx where he had been drinking and he stated he had been in the Brunel Rooms all night. On a scale of one to ten I would say that at the start he was between 7-8 and this went down to a six after we went through custody (which took almost 2 hours anyway). He kept repeating the same story over and over again (almost word for word) which I would put down to his level of intoxication. He literally did not stop talking for the whole two hours. It should be noted that the door staff they had working outside Brunel Rooms did assist me and Tristan and from what I saw they seemed to be fairly on the ball. However I was not present when the huge ruckus occurred just after I left and I do not know what they were like then.

This incident links into incident 19 where a DJ that was booked to perform at the premises failed to turn up. This caused a disorder to occur at the premises where a male was injured. A male was initially arrested for being drunk and disorderly and became violent upon arrest, assaulting officers and causing one officer to sustain a fractured hand and another officer to have a bruised finger. Police officers used batons, incapacitant spray and force to gain control of this male.

#### PS 1623Spargo's Statement

I am a uniformed Police Sergeant stationed at Gablecross Police Station, Swindon. On Saturday 02<sup>nd</sup> November 2013 I began my duty at 2200 hours for a 2200 – 0700 shift.

At approximately 0300 hours I was in a marked police vehicle in company with PC 2580 OWERS. We were both wearing fluorescent police jackets and dressed in operational police uniform. At this time I heard PS 0894 Kinderman report a disorder outside of the Brunel Rooms, HAVELOCK SQUARE, Swindon. This information had come to him via the Scrip radio that town centre police officers were wearing. At 0306 hours I heard another officer who had got to scene asking for further police units to attend as there was an ongoing disorder.

On my arrival at the scene moments later there was a large crowd of people outside of the club. There were a number of doorstaff from the club in bright jackets. I saw an injured male on the floor sat with his back against the wall directly in front of the club. He was being tended to by two door supervisors and a couple of females. The door supervisors had wrapped a bandage around his head and I assured the females who were shouting at me that an ambulance was on its way to the scene. To my left I could see PC WINTER holding back two males. One of them was a tall black male who I now know to be xxxxx. He was distinctive because of his height, he was wearing a dark coloured hoody and jeans. The shorter male kept trying to get to the injured male on the floor, I understand that this was a relative of his but everytime he managed to get free and get over to the injured male he was interfering with the doorstaff who were providing emergency first aid.

Tensions were obviously running high outside of the club and I saw a number of other people being repeatedly pushed back by officers trying to keep the scene clear. The tall male and the short male persistently tried to get back towards the scene, swearing and shouting, raising their arms, not listening to any directions to leave. I heard both of them



being giving numerous instructions by officers but they failed to stop. At one point I took my PAVA spray from its holster as I thought xxxx was going to be arrested. I soon placed it back in its pouch and replaced it with my cuffs and had to handcuff the smaller male as he became aggressive towards police officers. He was then led away by SC 4161 WINTON.

In order to try and establish what had occurred I went in to the club and asked to be shown where the fight had started. I was shown to the VIP room. Staff had cleared most of the disorder. I could not see any blood but the room was dark. I could see some smashed fragments of a pink bottle on the floor. At 0323 hours I seized three pieces of pink glass from the VIP room floor as exhibit ASS/01.

I then went straight to the managers office where I watched the CCTV of the incident inside the club. It was impossible to see offenders, the screen was dark so I was unable to pass descriptions of offenders. I seized the CCTV copy from Manager Nathan HATTER at 0330 hours as exhibit ASS/02.

On leaving the club I seized from a female member of doorstaff a blood stained belt that she had taken off a male involved in the fight outside the club. Apparently he had been using this as a weapon to strike people. This belt was blood stained. I seized this as exhibit ASS/03 at approximately 0340 hours.

On leaving the club, I monitored the situation outside the club for approximately ten minutes with Insp 1011 LONGDEN. My attention was continually drawn to xxxx. He was stood approximately ten metres away to the right of the club as you look it. I could hear him use the word "FUCKING" loudly and constantly. It appeared to me that he was angry with one of his friends in the group he was with as they were trying to calm him down. He kept raising his hands and stomping off and then would come back to the group seconds later and more shouting would occur.

Insp LONGEN, PC 2530 WINTER and I eventually went to our police car which was parked to the left of the entrance of the club. I continued to watch xxxx from my drivers seat. I had a clear view of him. He went to the entrance of the club and appeared to be remonstrating with the doorstaff there.

We all exited the vehicle and went back over to support the door staff. I could hear a door staff member with fair coloured hair and a blue jacket under his tabard tell xxxx to leave the club entrance, he was firm, clear and told him to leave the vicinity of the club. PC WINTER was helping to escort the male away. xxxxx kept trying to get back to the club. Due to his

aggressive demeanour and that I feared a fight was going to break out. I took my cuffs that had been returned to me and placed one cuff on to xxxxx's right wrist. His long sleeved black hoody was in the way and I wasn't able to get the cuff to lock in place. xxxxx immediately began to struggle telling me to "FUCK OFF". As I had hold of his wrist through his jumper he was pulling away from me and wriggling his arm up out of his sleeve and I saw his hand come out of the neck of his jumper and I was holding on to his sleeve. There were members of his friends trying to get involved and xxxxx was clearly trying to resist arrest. I said to him that he was under arrest but did not get chance to say what for, or to caution him or to explain the necessity as he began to violently struggle against me. PC WINTER was assisting me and we were able to get him against the passenger side door of the police car. We were telling him to calm down, to stop struggling. PC WINTER told xxxxx that he was under arrest for being drunk and disorderly. PC WINTON and I had hold of an arm each, with xxxxx body leant against the car and xxxxx then said "I'M GOING TO FUCKING SMASH YOU UP" or words similar. They were clearly meant as a threat or intention towards PC WINTER and I. I could feel him tense up against my hold and then he began to really struggle. We ended up moving away from the car as we tried to restrain him and I heard PC WINTER say to take him to the ground. I put out my right leg, placed in front of xxxxx and tried to take him to the ground. This didn't work as he was able to step over my leg. I then got out my PAVA and sprayed it directly in to his face.

Somehow myself, PC WINTER and xxxxx did end up on the floor. PC WINTER was on his back, a most vulnerable position in a disorder, xxxxx crouching on either his knees or toes but his torso over PC WINTER and I believe I fell to my knees. I put my weight on to xxxxx's back trying to push him prone to the floor but was shaken off. I was really concerned for PC WINTER, I could see fear on his face, he was trying to push xxxxx off him, he was shouting at him to stop assaulting him and telling him that he was further arrested for assault on police. I grabbed xxxxx in a bear hug around his stomach and was just hanging on trying to get some compliance but to also stop him struggling or making off from us. I was aware of his friends all crowding round us, getting involved and I think trying to pull us away from the male. INSP LONGDON came to help.

Somehow we ended up on our feet against the wall of the club I still had my arms around xxxxx's waist with my head lowered and I think under his arm. I was aware that PC WINTER and INSP LONGDEN were behind me. I could hear PC WINTER then shouting "LET GO OF MY HAND, LET GO OF MY FUCKING HAND". It was clear from his pitch, tone and shout that he was in pain. I believe that it was at this time that I pressed my emergency button to get more officers to the scene quickly. My PAVA canister had been knocked out of my hand during this disorder and I could see it lay on the street. I was very concerned that



somebody would pick it up and use it against us or other members of the public. I shouted to a doorman to pick it up and keep it safe. As xxxx was still struggling against us and we didnt seem to be getting any compliance, I took out my ASP baton, racked it with my right hand and began to strike him against the back of his right thigh. I was aiming for the large muscle mass and was careful to avoid the back of his knee. Due to our close proximity I struck him three or four times but without any great power generation.

At this point a black female wearing a grey top grabbed my baton. She was yelling at me to stop hitting him and saying "WHAT ARE YOU HITTING HIM FOR". I told her numerous times to let go of my baton and we were having a tug of war. As one hand was still wrapped around xxxxxs waist I only had one hand to pull back my baton. I recognised this female as being present when the doorstaff were treating the injured male from the earlier related incident. The doorman with the blue jacket came over and grabbed him from behind, holding her with his arms. I said that she had been very helpful earlier and I didnt want to have to spray her in order to get my baton back and in order to arrest her. She then gave up her grip on the baton. I believe that the doorstaff had placed a cordon around us to try and stop others interfering with the arrest.

At this point xxxxx was in cuffs and was able to be taken to the police car. Lots of people were filming us on their mobile phones. xxxxxx friend was stating that he wanted to be arrested and was wandering up to the police car but was kept away by the proactive doorman. I retrieved my PAVA canister and also my epaulette that had been ripped from my jacket.

There was a long queue to get into the custody holding area so I assisted custody staff by booking in prisoners that were unrelated to any incidents I had attended. When xxxx was brought into custody, I provided the grounds to PS Flynn as PC WINTER had been taken to Great Western Hospital. Whilst giving the grounds I received an update that PC WINTER had a broken left hand. At 0520 hours I said to xxxx "I am arresting you on suspicion of greivous bodily harm on a police officer as the injury is more severe than originally thought". I reminded him that he was under caution and repeated it to him. He made no reply, just nodded his head.

Due to this incident and the very violent nature of xxxx, I have a bruised left ring finger which is quite painful, a blood bruise present on my left knee and a swelling to my lower right shin. My left side of face was sore at the time of the incident, I think from the general scrum of being tucked into xxxxx body but this has since worn off.

At 0942 hours I produce my PAVA canister as exhibit ASS/04. At 0950 hours I handed exhibits ASS/01 – ASS/04 to PC SULTAN to book into the special property cupboard for me.

I would like to add that xxxxx was given multiple opportunities to leave the vicinity of the club from our arrival at 0300 until his arrest at 0352. He was constantly parading up and down for others to hear and see, raising his voice, being aggressive in his stance and manner, swearing and offering violence. When he threatened PC WINTER and I against the car, I genuinely believed that if he was able to get free he would cause one of us great injury, I was really scared for our safety. When PC WINTER was on the floor, he was on his back, really vulnerable and I could hear him shouting "STOP ASSAULTING ME".

In thirteen years of policing I have never had to use my ASP baton against someone. I had no option tonight and believe this shows the level of aggression and resistance xxxx put up to arrest.

### **Inspector Longdons statement**

At 0350 hours on Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2013, I was on foot patrol duty in high visibility uniform outside the Brunel Rooms (Club), Swindon when I assisted Sgt 1623 Spargo and PC 2530 Winter with the arrest of a male I now know to be xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx.

xxxxxxx had been around the outside of the club for around 20 minutes and had been shouting at the top of his voice and waving his arms around in manner that suggested he was seeking to offer violence to person/s unknown. The atmosphere was tense; the club had been let down on an act, customers were streaming out and miscellaneous persons were making offers and threats of violence to each other and xxxxx behaviour had helped to increase the level of fear and tension outside the club exit. However, due to Police Officers being committed elsewhere, it had not been practicable to arrest xxxxx and others.

At 0350 he was in the process of being arrested for being drunk and disorderly. However, the arrest was not progressing smoothly, in that; xxxx was offering extreme resistance to the arresting officers and there was a group of persons supportive of xxxxx and hostile to the officers (around the officers and OFORI).

Sgt 1623 Spargo and PC 2530 Winter were engaged in a struggle with xxxx and I would describe xxxx offer of violence and resistance to these officers as 9/10 (It would have been



10/10 had he been able to land any punches). xxxx resistance went far beyond any 'normal' resistance to arrest. He was using all of his power (circa 6'2" well built man) to try and overwhelm the officers and was seeking to acquire body 'targets' on the officers and land blows that would enable him to escape. Such was the force and fury of xxxx blind aggression and his immunity to pain (he is a very fit and youthful young man), that I believed that if he broke free; he was capable of killing another person, most likely myself or another officer, with his bare hands. I sensed we were about to be overwhelmed and he would use his size and power to inflict a very serious, potentially fatal attack. Therefore, as I was unable to make any impact on restraining him by use of my bare hands alone, I discharged my PAVA spray into his face, in the only way I could get a 'shot'; that is, approximately 12" away from his face. This flies in the face of approved teaching, but I believed the risk of minor injury to xxxxx eyes outweighed serious injury to myself and the other officers. Also, xxxx was buoyed up by the other friends who were shouting and egging him on to escape and the situation required a very quick decision. Two quick bursts of PAVA immediately caused xxxxx to put his hands to his face, he was handcuffed and led to the Police car, where he sat on the rear passenger seat for a few moments to clear his eyes. I consider my use of force to be lawful (enable arrest / prevent escape), necessary, reasonable and proportionate.

xxxx was taken directly to the custody unit at Gablecross Police Station, arriving circa 0405 hours. It is of note that on the return journey and whilst waiting in the custody holding area; xxxxx calmed down and was apologetic about his behaviour, for example stating that he had 'seen red' because he had seen his cousin injured earlier that morning.

Notwithstanding xxxx apparent regrets, at the time of his arrest – and at the time leading up to his arrest – I consider him to have exhibited highly dangerous behaviour and he was intent on offering and delivering violence to any person around him, such was the level of his temper.

## **Inspector Longdons additional statement**

Further to my previous statement regarding xxxxxxx and an incident outside the Brunel Rooms, Swindon at 0350 hours, I can confirm / clarify the following points:

- 1 – My previous statement (Niche time 0857 hours 031113) was written by me, but the 'header' containing my name and occupation did not 'save' on the computer, but I can confirm the statement is mine.
- 2 – At the time of the incident, I was the North night shift response uniform police Inspector, responsible for response policing across the North of Wiltshire and Swindon
- 3 – xxxxxx was wearing a dark blue T shirt and jeans and I seem to remember he had a dark top on over his T shirt earlier when he was outside the club entrance, prior to me help with his restraint.
- 4 – With regard to identification and continuity: I sawxxxx for approximately 20 minutes from his behaviour outside the entrance to the Brunel Rooms to his arrest, he was then under constant supervision with me until he was booked into custody, the distance between xxxx and I varied between 10 metres and extreme close contact as he fought, the lighting at the time was good due to the ambient street lighting and the bright lighting at the entrance to the club, there were no obstructions between myself and xxxxxl at the material times in that I had hold of him or I was between him and persons leaving the club in the instances before his arrest, I had never seen xxxxx before, at the time of arrest I remembered him for his disorderly behaviour outside the Brunel Rooms just minutes earlier, the whole arrest / compliance incident lasted approximately 2 minutes, I can state categorically that the person I saw outside the club behaving in a disorderly manner, the person I assisted in controlling when arrested and the person presented at the custody suite are the same person; xxxxxxx
- 5 - In my previous statement I describe xxxxx as 'offering extreme resistance': To clarify: xxxxx appeared to be using all of his body strength to resist the officers, raging like a wild animal; for example when Sgt SPARGO and PC WINTER attempted to grapple xxxx he shook them off as if he were a wild bucking bronco type animal.
- 6 – In my previous statement I describe xxxx as 'hostile to the officers': To clarify: xxxx showed all the classic signs of hostility; bared teeth, hyperventilation, clenched fists, wild gross motor movements thrashing his body and limbs about in a reckless manner, hands raised in combat position when able to do so. xxxx was in my opinion, simply out of control and wild with rage; by his own admission xxxxx stated he saw 'red', because his cousin had



been injured earlier. I remember xxxx bellowing or shouting, but I cannot remember what he said.

7 – In my previous statement I describe xxxx as 'engaged in a struggle': To clarify: there are no other words to describe his actions. Sgt SPARGO and PC WINTER were trying to arrest xxxx and he was resisting; he dragged them a number of metres along the pavement, from the club entrance area towards the loading area before I intervened. I was a few feet away and allowed Sgt SPARGO and PC WINTER time and space to try and subdue xxxx, but after a matter of seconds, I saw that the situation was clearly hopeless and there was a distinct possibility of xxxx and / or the crowd securing his release, so I grabbed xxxx and administered PAVA spray.

8 – In my previous statement, I describe a 'group of persons supportive of xxxxx and hostile to the officers: To clarify: there were approximately 6 persons around Sgts SPARGO and PC WINTER, they all appeared to be supportive of xxxx, they were packed close in, from a direct contact to a few feet away as they filmed, there were chants of 'racist, racist, racist', some person/s were filming the incident on their mobile phone/s and other person/s who appeared to be helping xxxx struggles; either by reason of their presence, or hindering the officers efforts to restrain xxxxx. However, in summary, I am glad the small crowd pressed around xxxx and the officers. The presence of the crowd tended to restrict xxxxx ability to move and escape, thereby reducing the possibility of him delivering any punches.

9 – In my previous statement, I describe xxxxx as 'seeking to acquire body 'targets: To clarify: xxxx exhibited the classic sign of target acquisition, looking at the officers in a way that suggested he was looking for some location that he could attack. This is a very distinct way of looking, as if someone is in a rugby scrum, looking for a space or gap to pass a ball.

10 – In my previous statement I describe how xxxxx would have 'landed blows that would enable him to escape': To clarify: xxxxx was moving his arms around in an aggressive manner with clenched fists, but was unable to land an effective punch due to the close proximity of the officers and the crowd around him. Therefore, he had to resort to gross body movements and attempting to walk in order to defeat the officers

11 – In my previous statement I describe xxxxx 'immunity to pain: To clarify: xxxxx was not responding to any forms of mechanical pain compliance or restraint. I grabbed him with my arm, he didn't even notice. I could detect PAVA spray in the vicinity and believed xxxxx had been sprayed, but he showed no sign of being subdued by this

12 – In my previous statement I describe how 'I sensed we were about to be overwhelmed:  
To clarify: I was afraid that xxxx would break free from the officers; if this happened, I  
believed that we were in immediate danger of him using potentially lethal unarmed force  
against us. Therefore, I sprayed my PAVA spray directly into xxxxx eyes at very close range.  
This produced an immediate effect, xxxx put his hands to his eyes and the struggle was  
over.

13 – I have been a Police Officer for over 29 years. This is the first time I have ever had to  
personally deploy PAVA spray. I could see no other way of protecting myself or the other  
officers from xxxxx.

Nathan,

Below are the points we went over today I have cut some bits out of the incidents where Officers statements have been included so as not to make it too long and added some points that were raised today in blue.

We discussed the 0600hours events – it was agreed that you would supply police with up to date numbers and a breakdown of where those attending are from so that we can carry out an assessment of our resources etc

I will ask our resource management and Inspector to look at the resources required for the 19/10/13 and let you know costings as soon as possible.

We then started going through the points from the opening weekend. These are detailed below and either come from my own observations or from logs etc that are put on by officers.

1. 01/08/13 2045hours licensing officers attend venue to walk around. Whilst there bar staff have been asked about training in the Amphi bar. They said they had been trained in relation to fire safety, bar work, drunkenness and underage. They were asked if they supplied drinking water the reply to this was that it was only supplied in bottles for a charge. – mandatory condition is that drinking water is supplied. They were also asked about how they contact door staff for assistance. You have spoken with staff and this has been addressed.
2. Informed by security that the smoking area was going to be limited to 40 persons and no drinks allowed outside to help stop people lingering. Visit at 23.45hours. Observed that the area leading to the smoking area was very busy and uncontrolled a scuffle broke out in front of us. There was no attempt to limit people moving into the area by DS and it was very congested up there. People were also going out there with their drinks. The smoking area is limited and will be no drinks outside to limit the time customers spend out there in order to reduce the levels of noise.
3. 2345 hours walk around premises. DS hard to spot within the premises due to the low lighting and the black jackets. Suggested that the yellow tabards are used inside. This has been addressed.
4. 02/08/13 0012hours. DT01 located heavily intoxicated female outside Brunel rooms. She is with her boyfriend but it is obvious she has been served in this state. Taken from Main NTE log.
5. 2.20hours 6454 attended Brunel Rooms. Checking numbers with DS and asked if there had been many issues tonight. She had recorded 12 ejections and had only had a few



issues on the door. It had just kicked off prior to my arrival involving Jack Savages family. There were lots of groups hanging around the area with approx 6 DS gathered at the entrance. A female threw a barrier at DS shouting at them for an unknown reason. DS were still stood in the entrance.

Whilst stood at the entrance I was aware of Aaron Woolford who informed me that he was wasted on the Wednesday night and he was asking DS why he had been stopped from buying more drink. I highlighted that he might not want to continue this conversation in front of me! The DS I was talking to at the time indicated that he probably shouldn't be drinking whilst working and he said it's a perk of the job and he stated he wasn't that pissed tonight. We discussed that this is not a professional attitude for someone involved in the running of a nightclub and that it reflects badly on the management as a whole.

6. At 0232 some pushing and shoving broke out at the front of the premises and I called up on the radio for units to attend location. Shortly after this a male behind me was pushed into a bollard which made contact with his head. DS then started to react as other people then got involved.
7. Police arrived and detained 2 persons in the disorder one was arrested and kicked off and a welcoming committee had to be arranged for custody. In the meantime there was still groups shouting and swearing. Further units were requested at the location to help deal with the crowd. There were issues at the van and a XXX was arrested for obstruction and assault police this then caused further disorder and she was dearrested. Police officers note that she was intoxicated and in order to maintain staffing numbers it was decided she would be dealt with slow time. 73033 02/08/13 02.32 hours Male arrested D and D

PC 2552 MILLER arrested XXXX for being drunk and disorderly on Havelock Square, Swindon, outside the 'Brunel Rooms' night club at 0230hrs on 01/08/13.

There was a large disorder between door staff and the family and friends of XXXXX who recently died, the night was supposed to be a tribute to him. Police tried to assist the door staff but some of the persons became out of hand including XXXX, leading to his arrest. Because XXX was arrested, family and friends then turned against Police as well and proceeded to try to release XXXX from the police van. The situation became very tense and numerous persons became involved.

8. 6454 highlighted to Head doorman that he may want to pull more units down to the front to help the dispersal of customers as this is what the dispersal policy is for so people don't hang around and start fighting. I was informed that it was all to do with the Savage family and that they had left an hour ago but kept hanging around the premises. Here we discussed how the private rooms are monitored to ensure that levels of drunkenness do not become unacceptable. I note that these are monitored by the door staff regularly as well as bar staff.
9. Outside the premises there were several females who could barely stand. 1 female was bouncing into the wall. A second could hardly stand up and was helped off by her friends. Later on in the evening perhaps get staff to become more aware of the customers behavior etc so that they are picked up on before the end of the night.



10.02.50hours a female was inside the premises having collapsed and was awaiting an ambulance.? I'm not sure if this incident happened or not so can you check your incident log for this one.

11. Log 71 of 02/08/13 05.17

Intox male located at kingshill service station and had to be taken home by police. He had sustained a cut lip by unknown means and disclosed he had been at the brunel rooms for the opening night.

12. Email received from the SGT on the 01/08/13 stating that the crowd from the Brunel rooms was volatile and officers had to concentrate on crowd dispersal for safety reasons. He highlighted that all they were dealing with were heavily intoxicated and the doorstaff helped officers out. The sgt gave some positive feedback in relation to the assistance from doorstaff in this incident.

13. Log 89 of 03/08/13 \*73397 03.50 Fri

Male has assaulted a group of people on Canal Walk after following them. In interview males states he had been to the Brunel rooms and consumed a number of brandy and cokes. He was quite drunk and couldn't remember much of the night's events when he was questioned the next day.

14. Saturday 03/08/13

When attending the premises for a visit some males that appeared to be travelers were being ejected. The doorstaff were confrontational and continued arguing with one male rather than walking away and letting another member of DS take over. We discussed that this could have been handled better and that you are monitoring this at the door.

15. \*73641 04/08/13 01.08 Sat

Male has exited the premises and was seen acting disorderly. Male refused to quieten down when asked by officers and was arrested for Drunk and Disorderly. Officers statements identify the male as being drunk.

16. Log 53 of 05/08/13 Sunday

Jason Ranford has been abusing door staff and customers at a town centre premises following being refused entry resulting in police being called due to Ranford remaining in the area. He was given WOA by Police officers to stay away from the premises. We discussed once again the level of professionalism of your staff and particularly as this was after his pubwatch ban hearing.

17. PS Nix from weekend NTE duty on 9/10/08/13 - Appears that there are fire doors without alarms (at least on Level 2). 1 patron exited through the fire doors and then ran around the roof area before being detained by BRUNEL Security, not BRUNEL ROOMS door staff (enqs ongoing) You were aware of this and the doors are now alarmed.

Kathryn and I also looked over your training and Kathryn will send on the up to date documents for you to amend. It seemed to cover the main points required.

Kathryn also raised the issue of noise and that there have been some complaints from the DMJ residents. She will address these with you and you will also provide the noise assessment so that a noise containment policy can be drawn up as per the licence condition.


On the whole the first couple of weeks have been ok with only a few issues that in the main have been sorted out. There have been a few arrests linked to the premises and as you are aware these are monitored by us and we can discuss these at each meeting we have. If you have any questions regarding the above feel free to give me a call.

Nathan,

Please see below summary and the incidents we discussed from yesterday's meeting.

The following Incidents were discussed

1. Log and related intelligence of a disorder discussed due to the fact that it involved some known individuals that were all on pubwatch bans for various things. They were supposedly let in by Ranford and caused a number of issues inside and walked out of the venues with bottles. They then had a fight a bit further away from the venue which we were called to deal with and no complaint were forthcoming. This occurred on the August BH **26/08/13**.
2. On one licensing inspection made 07/09/13 by myself and PC Diffin we found Ranford using a weapon wand at the bottom of the stairs with very few ds around. We saw ds upstairs and asked them what was going on and they informed us they had to check on the people Jason had just let in. Ranford is not SIA badged and should not be carrying out door staff duties including searches of people.
3. Discussed DS checking and searches of customers who are re-entering the building whether they says it's for cash point etc as the male arrested for poss. ketamine said he had been in and out of the venue a few times and had obtained it outside. Nathan agreed that this would be brought up with door staff to introduce the checks on those individuals who re enter.
4. discussed the "private party" that took place last week – We ended up having to deal with some high intox people that had been injured as a result of a fight that occurred. The CCTV shows there was no control over what was going on inside. Nathan stated he wasn't happy about this and saw the CCTV from Brunel security outside and agreed that it was a mess. Email received from PC 2352 " There was a large fight which started inside the venue and spilled out on to the ramp. The fight on the ramp has been caught on CCTV, however this was not available to us immediately as they were having technical difficulties. Details of the people involved were taken. 2 bar staff were spoken to who stated there were no security staff on this evening. Brunel security can also confirm that. A couple of the people we stopped also stated there were no security staff and they had to intervene when a male started kicking off and throwing glasses and bottles at people, they said RANFORD couldn't handle it and was in a flighty mood."

5. **\*85534 08/09/13 01.38 Saturday**

Male has come out of the Brunel rooms and has then chased another male after being racially abused. One of these individuals has dropped a knife. This could not be proven as to which one it was. DS have given chase. The male that had been at the premises that evening states he was drunk and had consumed about 10-11 pints throughout the night. This male was drunk and aggressive and received a Caution for public order. DS were helpful in dealing with this incident.

6. **\*90190 22/09/13 02.45-0300 Saturday**

Known male suspect has thrown glasses (drinking) and contents of the glasses at the IP causing anxiety and distress, these have hit the IP in face and on leg. Both parties in a public place (night club). The car of the IP has also been damaged which the male had threatened to do. Statements and CCTV enquiries ongoing.

- There are 3 further incidents from Thursday night 04/10/13

7. **\*94374 Log 22 of 04/10/13 01.21 Thursday**

Police called to the venue to an aggressive male who had been ejected. Officers were dealing when he became abusive so was arrested D&D. Male states he had been drinking all evening.

8. **\*94396 04/10/13 01.21 Thursday linked to above**

Officers attended disturbance at a/l Male was arrested D&D However on arrival at custody male was seen to have sustained an injury to his left cheek bone with some large swelling. Male was conveyed to GWH. Further enquiries have shown that suspect was involved in assault. Officers have viewed CCTV at Brunel Security and

an arrest has been made.

9. **\*94391 Log 48 of 04/10/13 03.07 Thursday**

An argument occurred at the venue and DS intervened. 2 females then went to commercial road to get some cash for a taxi and the other group involved in the argument came resulting in a female assaulting the 2 females and a theft of the mobile phone. 2 cars were also involved and drove off after the assault. No statements could be taken from witnesses or victims as they were heavily intoxicated and the story changed many times and all parties were hysterical.

Other incidents that are linked to the premises were discussed that have Ranford as a suspect on the file and for one reason or another complaints have not been continued by the victims. We discussed that there is a common theme running through the incidents we discussed and it is up to you to control and manage what is going on at the premises. I have attached the management structure that was sent to me prior to opening and if the roles have changed then this will need updating. I also explained my concern at having Jason on the front door and carrying out duties



that should be done with the doorstaff as well as overriding entry policy for his friends and acquaintances that could potentially put your venue at risk. I advised that you speak to the licence holders and ensure that his duties are in line with the management plan.

Also discussed was the 0600hours trance event on the 19<sup>th</sup>. Numbers were asked for and it was mentioned that Gatecrasher have a similar night on so this is likely to effect numbers attending. We discussed whether payment had been agreed due to Jason questioning the payment and Sgt McLaughlin's email sent earlier today. I advised you that it was cheaper to pay for the 2 rather than the whole lot for 3 hours. You said it had been agreed.

We spoke about irresponsible drinks promotions particularly in relation to Thursdays and I advised you that you should be careful about what drinks offers you put on particularly when there are doubles etc.

It was discussed about the cheaper drinks elsewhere in the town and the fact that due to the number of promotions going on and increase in ASB over the last month if I can make links to incident occurring we will be looking for a prosecution. You assured me that you were aware of this and didn't want to go any lower than they already are and that you were advising the owners of this.

I also informed you of the complaints I have had that relate to your business that don't concern me but I have had calls reporting rude staff members after they had been served the wrong drink and asked for the correct one and the customer being told they would be chucked out if they weren't so quiet. As I stated this is your business and although I'm no bar manager these customers probably won't be returning due to their experiences.

**Brunel Rooms – 07/10/13 13.30 Gablecross police station**

Present – Inspector Burt, Sian Kalynka, Helene Simpkins, Paula Harris and Nathan Hatter.

Meeting was held to discuss the assault that occurred on Thursday night at the premises that involved Jason Ranford one of the directors at the Brunel Rooms.

Insp Burt made them aware that he wishes to see businesses thriving but he has concerns about the involvement of Ranford and the safety of the customers at the venue.

HS highlighted that Jason had played down the incident and that he had been held because of another matter and not in relation to the assault. They were informed that he had been charged.

They were informed that we could not go too much into the assault but that we were disappointed with how doorstaff handled the situation and how poor the recording of the offence is entered into the incidents book.

HS stated that when he is drinking Jason does things that he shouldn't and she had asked that Andy Anderson head doorman not let Jason in when he has been drinking.

The difficulties of this were highlighted in that Jason would override Andy saying that he is their boss etc. And this puts people in a difficult position. This was put to Nathan who said he has never had to tell Jason to do something.

Helene stated that she thought he had been better since the club opened as he sees son and has a new flat and has something to occupy his time. She wasn't overly aware of his previous history but knew his previous in that he would rent a house and then not pay rent etc.

She stated he was a director of the business and that this would not stop but that he would not be on the front door anymore and would not let him drink at the premises.

It was asked why they allowed him to be on the front door and Helene said it was because he liked being there and looked after his friends from Swindon Town and boxing etc

Sk brought up that there were issues around this and the individuals that were let in at one time were all involved in something or other and that they had all been on pubwatch at one point or another.

It was also highlighted that this was not the first time an assault of a customer had occurred and that we had received another report however the IP declined to make a statement and follow it up. However this was not the case in this instance.

They were asked to go away and talk things over and come back with a decision about what Ranford's involvement at the premises would be.

They asked if AB could talk to Andy Anderson about not letting Jason in as Jason respects his voice more than hers and Paula's and would take him more seriously.

Nathan was asked for his opinion as he had been quiet throughout the meeting and highlighted that this had been brought up previously and he was just going round in circles so there was no point. It was asked by Helene why he never said anything to Jason and Nathan said you can't tell the director of the business that he is having a negative impact on his business.

The meeting was concluded by Insp Burt discussing levels of drunkenness and promotions currently occurring in the town and that overall Brunel were doing ok and that he expected a few incidents but some premise were close to the line in relation to promotions etc.

# Club boss jailed for fraud and assault

JASON Ranford has been disassociated from the Brunel Rooms after being jailed for six months for two counts of fraud and two counts of common assault.

At Swindon Magistrates' Court on Wednesday, Ranford, 27, was sentenced to five months in prison for fraud while on a suspended sentence for common assault committed in February 2012.

Ranford, who was director at the club, pleaded not guilty to a new charge of common assault, which he was accused of committing on Sunday morning outside the town centre club.

But after hearing his sentence for the fraud charge, Ranford changed his plea to guilty, and chairman of the bench Roger Williams handed him an additional month behind bars.

At around 2am on October 4, Ranford assaulted clubber Adam Morrison after he had been ejected from the premises and was being handled by the bouncers on duty.

Nick Barr, for the prosecution, said: "The allegation is the defendant had gone outside the club where he works, where Mr Morrison had been ejected by security staff.

"The defendant gratuitously assaults the victim with repeated punches and stamps on him.

"The victim was being dealt with by licenced security staff before the defendant decides to take it upon himself to become involved.

"The whole incident is captured on CCTV outside the club."

Yesterday, a statement was posted on the Brunel Rooms Swindon Facebook page, which read: "In light of recent events, we feel it appropriate to release the following statement.

"Mr Jason Ranford will have no future involvement with the operation of the Brunel Rooms.

"It should also be clarified that although Mr Ranford's job title was Director, he had given no financial backing to the initiation of Brunel Rooms Ltd or its general operation.

"The company will continue to be licensed to and managed by Nathan Hatter, General Manager, with Paula Harris remaining as the sole Managing Director."

- Co-owner of the club, Helene Simpkins, has asked us to point out that Jason Ranford was not a director of the Brunel Rooms and he did not invest any money into the club whatsoever. She added: "We have had a lot of people contacting the club asking if we are closing down and we have assured them that is not the case.

"Jason was assistant manager to Nathan and helped us reopen the club.

"The money we used to open the club was ours.

"He was never a director and he wasn't involved in putting money up for the club.

"We are sorry about what has happened to him but all that was long before we opened the Brunel Rooms."
