I feel strongly on the following two points:

1. The club should not employ anyone with a criminal history in any capacity, and this should be written into the license
2. The opening hours should be severely reduced now that the Regents Circus development is underway. A club in town centre open until late at night will attract the pub crowd from Old Town when the pubs shut. The permeability of the Regents Circus development means that it is now the most direct way to walk from Old Town to Town Centre, along residential streets. Drunk people walking along residential streets at 2am have a track record of causing anti social behaviour and damaging property as they move through. The opening and last entry times in Town Centre should be harmonised with Old Town to stop the late night migration between the two that causes misery to residents
