Members may be aware that Mori are carrying out a Highway and Transport public survey on behalf of the Borough Council. Will the Chair of the Scrutiny please ask the Council Leader if he will undertake that the results and all comments collected will be publicised on the Council Website?

The Leader of the Council responded.

Thank you for your question. Yes, there is a national annual exercise underway that is used to compare performance between authorities; however, no authority receives the raw survey results and comments so the Council cannot publish it.

The Council is discussing both how to include the results in the new performance framework and the best way to publicise that.

Responders can include comments related to the individual local authority. These are shared with the local authority, but alongside and within the context of the rest of the survey. To do otherwise would have limited benefit.
