(WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS AND PARKING PLACES
EXPERIMENTAL ORDER (NO.3) 2016)NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 9th November 2016 Swindon Borough Council made an Experimental Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to be operative from the 18th November 2016 for the control of waiting and loading in Zone C.

The effect of the Order is to impose variations to the existing waiting and loading restrictions by introducing 'dual use' bays for limited waiting and loading for Zone C Parking Permits and by revoking waiting from the Residents Parking Bays in Zone C to remove a section of 'no waiting at any time' restriction of Milton Road to be replaced with 'dual use' bays for resident parking for Zone C Permit Holders.

The above variations will be indicated by signs and markings on the streets in Zone C:

Chester Street, Theobald Street, Maxwell Street, Iwerley Street and Milton Road.

A copy of the Order and plan showing the extent of each restriction on the streets may be inspected at the One Stop Shop, Wat Tyler House, Swindon during normal office hours or online on www.swindon.gov.uk

The Experimental Order has been made to allow for an assessment to be made before a decision is taken to make it permanent.

Any person wishing to make representations whether to object to or support the Order before it is made permanent must do so in writing quoting the reference to the Experimental/Zone C) specifying the grounds on which they object to the Experimental Order coming into force or if the Order is modified within 6 months of the variation or modification comes into force.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provisions of the Order that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may apply to the High Court for this purpose.
