Continue with the current interim management of the Hodson Embankment stability problem and maintain access for motor vehicles for as long as possible.2. Continue to investigate low cost Engineering and Geotechnical solutions to extend the useful life of the carriageway. This will involve detailed geotechnical and drainage surveys and a feasibility study as detailed in the report.

Decision(s): -	<p>That the adoption of the proposals for supporting the community sport sector, as set out in paragraphs 3.6 to 3.14 of the Decision Note be approved.</p> <p>That the Head of Localities, Community Involvement and Volunteering be authorised to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Establish with Wiltshire and Swindon Sport Partnership and with the Sports Forum appropriate arrangements to implement the proposals in the Decision Notice to take effect from 1st January 2017.2. Release from the Community Initiatives Fund the sum of £10k per annum for the next two years to be paid to Wiltshire and Swindon Sport Partnership to deliver the objectives set out in paragraph 3.11, commencing 1st January 2017.3. Seek match funding from Sport England over the same two year period.4. Initiate with immediate effect formal consultation with the affected postholder and UNISON regarding the staffing implications of these proposals.
