Please accept this e mail as a representation from Wiltshire Police to object to the TEN application dated between 20/04 – 25/04/2017 under the prevention of crime and disorder objective of the Licensing Act.

The evidence to support this application is that the location was found to be operating without a premise licence for a number of months without the knowledge of Police or Licensing authority.

In addition Licensing checks have been completed at the location and the owner was found to be employing persons illegally within the UK and there were continual breaches of the conditions that were on the licence.

Wiltshire Police also believe that the applicant has links to the owner and that the alcohol still in the store belongs to him and that he will still be operating the premise.
